

ORDINANCE NO. 1140.

TO VACATE A CERTAIN ALLEY BETWEEN BLACKHOOF STREET AND LOGAN STREET, IMMEDIATELY NORTH OF THE PRESENT BLUME HIGH SCHOOL SITE, AND A PORTION OF AN ALLEY, BEING FIFTY FEET IN LENGTH BETWEEN THE WEST END OF INLOT TWO HUNDRED AND FORTY-THREE, AND THE SOUTH ONE-THIRD OF INLOT NUMBER TWO HUNDRED AND SEVENTY, IN THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, OHIO.

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of March, 1923, a Petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of an alley, extending from Blackhoof Street to Logan Street, and adjoining Fraction Seven (7), of the present Blume High School site, on the north, and so much of an alley as lies between the west end of Inlot Number Two Hundred and Forty-three (243), and the south one-third of Inlot Two Hundred and Seventy (270), was duly presented to Council, praying that said alleys as so described between the points named, be vacated; and,

WHEREAS, the written consent to such vacation, by the owners of all the property abutting the parts of the alleys proposed to be vacated, was filed with said Petition; and,

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation, as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interests, and ought to be made; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, State of Ohio:

SEC. 1. That the alley extending from Blackhoof Street to Logan Street, between Fraction Seven(7) of the Blume High School site, immediately on the south, and Inlots Two Hundred and Forty-three (243), and the south one-third of Inlots Two Hundred and Seventy (270), Two Hundred Seventy-one (271), and Two Hundred and Seventy-two (272), and the alley between the west end of Inlot Two Hundred and Forty-three (243) and the east side of the south one-third of Inlot Two Hundred and Seventy (270), be, and the same are hereby vacated.

SEC. 2. That this Ordinance be and remain in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
