ORDUNANCE NO. 1036.

To Vacate the North End of Seltzer Street.

Whereas, on the 17th day of July, 1918, a petition signed by all the owners of the property abutting on the north end of Walkup street from the north line of Harrison street north to the first alley running east and west, being the length of one lot, giving the written consent of said abutting property owners to the vacation, was duly presented to Council praying that said street between the points named be vacated; and

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it is no longer of use to the public, that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interests and ought to be made, now therefore,

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, State of Ohio, as follows:

Sec. 1. That the north end of Seltzer street (also known as Walkup street) in the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, from the north line of Harrison street (also known as North street) to the first alley running east and west on the north, the length of one lot, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Sec. 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest day allowed by law.
