

Ordinance No. 43 to vacate.

Sec. I Be it ordained by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Napakuta Ohio, a majority of the members thereof concurring therein, that so much of what is known as Oak Alley, in the town of Napakuta, O. as extends from main to mechanics st, in said town, be, and the same is hereby vacated and dedicated to the Board of education of Napakuta, O. for school purposes.

Sec. II Be it further ordained that the ordinance heretofore adopted by this Council in accepting and dedicating said alley as a public highway, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. III This Ordinance to take effect and be in full force on and after its passage.
