

Ordinance No 582.

To narrow and vacate a certain portion of Main Street.

Whereas, on the 24th day of July, 1901, a petition was presented to the Council of the Village of Wapakoneta, Ohio, praying for the vacation and narrowing of Main Street in said Village from the West line of Perry Street to the East line of Blackhoof Street by vacating a strip eight (8) inches in width off of the south side of said Main Street between the points named, notice of the Petition and prayer of which has been given as required by law, and

Whereas, upon hearing the Council is satisfied that there is good cause for such narrowing, and that the same would not be detrimental to the general interest and should be made, therefore

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Wapakoneta, Ohio, That a strip eight (8) inches in width off of the south side of Main Street in said Village from the West line of Perry Street to the East line of Blackhoof Street be and the same be hereby narrowed accordingly, and that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
