Section 19, St. Marys Twp.**

According to the FEMA flood rate map 39011C0090 C (attached), this particular parcel of ground is not with the flood plain. The filling of this parcel with dredge material will not impact any flood plain areas located along the south side of Grand Lake St. Marys and therefore, a permit from my department is not necessary.

It is recommended however that the natural surface drainage of this parcel be maintained throughout the project. Attached is a watershed map from the Vornholt Single County Drainage Ditch that was petitioned and installed 19 years ago. The dashed line represents the watershed boundary and seven acres of this parcel flows to the east and into the Vornholt ditch. It is critical, that after the fill is completed on this parcel, that the flow of surface water be maintained from what existed prior to the work. Not only for the seven acres flowing into the Vornholt Ditch, but also for the remaining 28 acres on this property.

This is in regard to your letter of April 13, 2004, concerning the proposed hydraulic dredging of approximately 22,360 cubic yards of sediment from the Southshore Acres Libby Channel area of Grand Lake St. Marys in Mercer and Auglaize Counties, Ohio. The dredged material would be discharged in an approved dredged material relocation area authorized by Department of the Army Permit 199701400. We have reviewed the submitted data relative to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.

We have determined that your proposal is authorized under the provisions of our Nationwide Permit (NWP) 33 CFR 330 (16) for Return Water from Upland Contained Disposal Areas as published in the Federal Register on January 15, 2002. We do require compliance with the enclosed Terms and Conditions of the NWP and the Ohio State Certification Special Conditions.

This verification is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter. The enclosed Compliance Certification should be signed and returned upon completion of the project.
