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Surveyor's Description for a 68.741 Acre Parcel Referenced as Permanent Parcel #A03-017-007-01

The following described parcel of land is a part of the East half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 17, Clay Township, Town-6-South, Range-7-East, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is referenced as Permanent Parcel #A03-017-007-01 as referenced by Deed Volume OR 721, Page 5290, and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a Railroad Spike (found) over a Section Stone situated at the Northwest corner of the East half of the Northeast Ouarter of said Section 17, Clay Township, Town-6-South, Range-7-East, Auglaize County, Ohio;

Thence with a bearing of S. 00°-40′-19″ W. along the West line of the East half of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 17, Clay Township, and the legal centerline of Geyer Road, County Road #207, for a distance of 366.96 feet to a Mag Nail (found) and the PLACE OF BEGINNING;

Thence with a bearing of S. 88°-25'-17" E. along the North line of said Permanent Parcel #A03-017-007-01, for a total distance of 1,335.67 feet to a 4½ inch diameter steel post (found), passing thru an Iron Pin (found) at a distance of 25.06 feet, and passing thru an Iron Pin (found) on the Westerly side of the Indiana and Ohio Railroad at a distance of 1,021.34 feet, and passing thru a 41/2 inch diameter steel post (found) on the Easterly side of the Indiana and Ohio Railroad at a distance of 1,090.69 feet;

Thence with a bearing of S. 00°-37'-21" W. along the East line of the East half of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 17, Clay Township, for a total distance of 2,281.23 feet to a Mag Nail (found), passing thru an Iron Pin (set) on the Easterly side of the Indiana and Ohio Railroad at a distance of 801.18 feet, and passing thru an Iron Pin (set) on the Westerly side of the Indiana and Ohio Railroad at a distance of 1,027.97 feet, and passing thru an Iron Pin (set) on the Northerly right-of-way line of Gutman Road (T.R. #116) at a distance of 2,261.23 feet;

Thence with a bearing of N. 88°-59′-53″ W. along the South line of the East half of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 17, Clay Township, and the legal centerline of Gutman Road (T.R. #116), for a distance of 1,337.49 feet to a Monument Box (found);

Thence with a bearing of N. 00°-40′-19″ E. along the West line of the East half of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 17, Clay Township, and the legal centerline of Geyer Road, County Road #207, for a distance of 2,294.67 feet to a Mag Nail (found) and the original PLACE OF BEGINNING. Containing in all 70.197 Acres of land.

Save and Except: All that part of the Indiana and Ohio Railroad that traverses diagonally through the above described parcel of land, being further described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a Railroad Spike (found) over a Section Stone situated at the Northwest corner of the East half of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 17, Clay Township, Town-6-South, Range-7-East, Auglaize County, Ohio;

Thence with a bearing of S. 00°-40′-19″ W. along the West line of the East half of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 17, Clay Township, and the legal centerline of Geyer Road, County Road #207, for a distance of 366.96 feet to a Mag Nail (found);

Thence with a bearing of S. 88°-25′-17″ E. along the North line of said Permanent Parcel #A03-017-007-01, for a distance of 1,021,34 feet to an Iron Pin (found) on the Westerly side of the Indiana and Ohio Railroad and the PLACE OF BEGINNING;

Thence continuing with a bearing of S. 88° -25'-17'' E. for a distance of 69.35 feet to a $4\frac{1}{2}$ inch diameter steel post (found) on the Easterly side of the Indiana and Ohio Railroad;

Thence with a bearing of S. 16°-17′-46″ E. along the Easterly side of the Indiana and Ohio Railroad, for a distance of 841.70 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

Thence with a bearing of S. 00°-37′-21″ W. along the East line of the East half of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 17, Clay Township, for a distance of 226.79 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

Thence with a bearing of N. 16°-17′-46″ W. along the Westerly side of the Indiana and Ohio Railroad, for a distance of 1,079.96 feet to an Iron Pin (found) and the original PLACE OF BEGINNING. This section of the Indiana and Ohio Railroad containing in all 1.456 Acres of land traversing diagonally through said Permanent Parcel #A03-017-007-01.

The above described parcel of land contains a net acreage of 68.741 Acres of land, of which, 1.919 Acres being previously dedicated for highway purposes. Of the total net acreage of 68.741 Acres, 66.488 Acres is situated West of the Railroad, and 2.253 Acres is situated East of the Railroad. The above described parcel of land is also subject to any or all legal easements, reservations, or restrictions, if any, upon said premises.

The basis of bearings used for this survey and legal description assumed that the bearing of the West line of the East half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 17, Clay Township, has a bearing of N. 00°-40′-19″ E. consistent with a prior survey performed by Eric Pfenning P.S. #8129 (see Survey Book 0, Page 392, Auglaize County Map Office.

This legal description was prepared from an actual survey performed by Ted K. Schnell, PS #7216 (Ohio) on April 26 & 27, 2023. A plat of this survey is recorded with the Auglaize County Engineer's Map Office. Refer to Survey CLA-17-01.

The above described 68.741 Acre parcel of land is referenced as Permanent Parcel #A03-017-007-01 as referenced by Deed Volume OR 721, Page 5290.
