



Holcomb Survey

Real Estate situated in the Village of New Bremen, German Township, Auglaize County, State of Ohio and bounded and described as follows:

Tract 1.

Being the north part of Outlot Number 8 in Schroeder's North Addition (Plat Book 1A, Page 77) and in the north half of the southeast quarter of Section 10, Town 7 South, Range 4 East, commencing at a railroad spike at the intersection of centerlines of Main Street and Knoxville Avenue in said Village; thence North $00^{\circ} 10' 42''$ West 223.28 feet along the centerline of Main Street to a P.K. Nail; thence South $87^{\circ} 43' 40''$ East 21.07 feet to an iron pin for the true point of beginning;

thence North $00^{\circ} 38' 29''$ West 120.04 feet along the east right of way line of Main Street to an iron pin;

thence South $89^{\circ} 59' 00''$ East 252.93 feet along the north line of said Outlot Number 8 to an iron pin;

thence South $41^{\circ} 44' 09''$ West 168.18 feet along the west right of way line of Knoxville Avenue to an iron pin;

thence North $87^{\circ} 43' 40''$ West 139.74 feet to the point of beginning containing 0.557 acres of land more or less.

Said tract shall also be subject to highways and any other easement or restriction of record.

Real Estate situated in the Village of New Bremen, German Township, Auglaize County,
State of Ohio and bounded and described as follows:

Tract 2.

Being a part of a platted street described in William Heine's Subdivision (Plat Book 1B,
Page 138 and 139) in said Village and in the northeast quarter of Section 10, Town 7
South, Range 4 East, commencing at a railroad spike at the intersection of the centerlines
of Main Street and Boesel Avenue in said Village; thence South $89^{\circ} 59' 00''$ East 25.00
feet to an iron pin for the true point of beginning;

thence continuing South $89^{\circ} 59' 00''$ East 265.73 feet along the north line of the 19.8 foot
street in said William Heine's Subdivision to the Village of New Bremen, to an iron pin;

thence South $41^{\circ} 44' 09''$ West 26.53 feet along the west right of way line of Knoxville
Avenue to an iron pin;

thence North $89^{\circ} 59' 00''$ East 248.01 feet along the north line of Outlot Number 8,
Schroeder's Addition to said Village, to a point, witness an iron pin North $89^{\circ} 59' 00''$
West 4.92 feet;

thence North $00^{\circ} 10' 42''$ West 19.80 feet to the point of beginning containing 0.117 acre
of land more or less.
