

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

BEING PART OF A 64.724 ACRE TRACT OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF NEW BREMEN AS DESCRIBED IN OFFICIAL RECORD 508, PAGE 1515 OF THE AUGLAIZE COUNTY DEED RECORDS, SITUATE IN SECTION 15, TOWN 7 SOUTH, RANGE 4 EAST, GERMAN TOWNSHIP, VILLAGE OF NEW BREMEN, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO, AND BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Commencing for reference at an iron pin found at the northeast corner of Bunker Hill Sixth Addition as shown in Plat Cabinet C, Page 270 of the Auglaize County Plat Records and also being the Grantor's southeast property corner;

thence, South 86°-02'-49" West, 1109.99 feet, along the north property line of said Bunker Hill Sixth Addition and the Grantor's south property line to an iron pin with cap set on the north right-of-way line of Striene Drive and being the principal place of beginning for the tract herein conveyed;

thence, South 86°-02'-49" West, 823.89 feet, along the said north right-of-way of Striene Drive to an iron pin with cap set on the east property line of a tract of land owned by Community Improvement Corporation of New Bremen as described in Official Record 249/884;

thence, North 04°-00'-32" West, 775.00 feet along the east property line of said C.I.C. tract to an iron pin with cap set;

thence, North 86°-02'-49" East, 824.64 feet, to an iron pin with cap set;

thence, South 03°-57'-11" East, 775.00 feet, to the principal place of beginning.

Containing 14.665 acres and all being subject to any legal highways and easements of record;

The bearings are based on Bunker Hill Sixth Addition as Recorded in Plat Cabinet C, Page 270 of the Auglaize County Plat Records.
