- 1) The "Grantors" (City of St. Marys) of these Parcels A, B, and C, shall retain perpetual easements located behind the existing road right—of—ways of St. Marys River Road (County Road #41—A) and Markley Road (Township Road #150) as shown on this Survey Plat, specifically for the purposes of the installation of future public utility services.
- 2) The Basis of Bearings used for this Survey assumed the West line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34, Noble Township, and the legal centerline of St. Marys River Road (County Road #41—A), bears N. 01°-07'-04" E. and is consistent with the Auglaize County Engineer's global positioning survey and coordinate system.
- 3) The centerline of Markley Road pavement is not centered on the North line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34. The Monument Box (found) at the Northeast Corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34, Noble Township, contains a Stone (found) by the Auglaize County Engineer, and is situated in the Southerly road ditch of Markley Road.
- 4) This survey is on file with the Auglaize County Engineer's Map Office, filed at SURVEY NOB-34-07.



SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION PARCEL A – 9.099 Acres

The following described parcel of land is a part of the West half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34, Noble Township, Town-5-South, Range-4-East, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at an Iron Bar in a Monument Box (found) situated at the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 34, Noble Township, and also being the intersection of the legal centerline of St. Marys River Road (County Road #41-A), with the legal centerline of Markley Road (Township Road #150), and the PLACE OF BEGINNING;

Thence with a bearing of S. 88°-51'-16" E. along the North line of the West half of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 34, Noble Township, and along the legal centerline of Markley Road (Township Road #150), for a distance of 655.87 feet to a Mag Nail (set);

Thence with a bearing of S 01° - 15° - 12° W. and parallel with the East line of the West half of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 34, Noble Township, for a distance of 605.00 feet to an Iron Pin (set), and passing thru an Iron Pin (set) for reference on the Southerly right-of-way line of Markley Road (Township Road #150), at a distance of 16.50 feet;

Thence with a bearing of N. 88°-51'-16" W. and parallel with the North line of the West half of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 34, Noble Township, and the legal centerline of Markley Road (Township Road #150), for a distance of 654.44 feet to a Mag Nail (set), and passing thru an Iron Pin (set) for reference on the Easterly right-of-way line of St. Marys River Road (County Road #41-A), at a distance of 629.44 feet;

Thence with a bearing of N. 01°-07'-04" E. along the West line of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 34, Noble Township, and along the legal centerline of St. Marys River Road (County Road #41-A), for a distance of 605.00 feet to an Iron Bar in a Monument Box (found) and the original PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The above described Parcel of land is being referred to as Parcel A of a survey plat as filed with the Auglaize County Engineer's Map Office (See Survey NOB-34-07) and contains 9.099 Acres of land, of which, 0.586 Acre being previously dedicated for highway purposes.

The above described Parcel of land shall be subject to a perpetual 5 foot wide easement along the entire West side of the Parcel, and shall be located parallel to and immediately East of the existing 25 foot right-of-way line of St. Marys River Road (County Road 41-A), and is also subject to a perpetual 13.50 foot wide easement along the entire North side of the Parcel, and shall be located parallel to and immediately South of the existing 16.50 foot right-of-way line of Markley Road (Township Road #150), both easements specifically to the benefit of the City of St. Marys for future installation of public utility services.

Thence with a bearing of S. 88°-51'-16" E. along the North line of the West half of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 34, Noble Township, and along the legal centerline of Markley Road (Township Road #150), for a distance of 1,330.87 feet to a Gin Spindle (found);
