

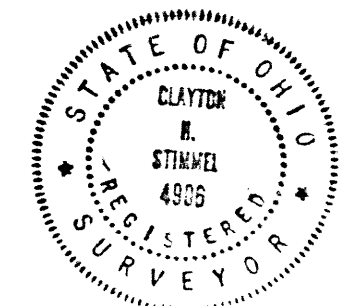
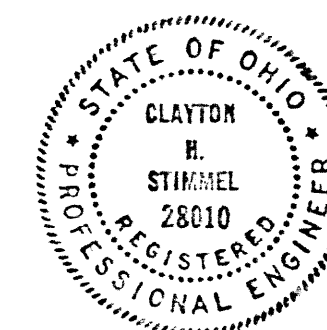
SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE  
for  
MAURICE BECKER

The following tract of land is part of the east half of Section 20, Salem Township, T14S, R4E with respect to the First Principal Meridian, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of County Road No. 226 (CR 226) formerly known as the Deep Cut Road), State Route No. 116 North, and State Route No. 116 East, this intersection being on the north-south half section line of Section 20;  
thence S89°-26'E along the centerline of State Route No. 116 a distance of 879.95 feet to a railroad spike which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING;  
thence N00°-36'W a distance of 2830.40 feet to a railroad spike in the centerline of Salem Township Road No. 230 (TR 230) formerly called the Valine Road;  
thence N89°-30'E along the centerline of TR 230 a distance of 477.47 feet to a railroad spike;  
thence S00°-36'E a distance of 2635.27 feet to an iron pin;  
thence N89°-26'W a distance of 228.68 feet to an iron pin;  
thence S00°-36'E a distance of 196.00 feet to a railroad spike in the centerline of SR116;  
thence N89°-26'W along the centerline of SR116 a distance of 248.79 feet to the railroad spike which was the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The above tract contains 30.0 acres which is subject to 0.39 acre which has been dedicated to the use of the public for highway purposes.
