LEGAL DESCRIPTION

BEING A SUBDIVISION OF A PART OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 2, TOWN 6S, RANGE 4E, ST. MARYS TOWNSHIP, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO, AND BEING MORE FULLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Commencing for reference at a 6 inch diameter wood corner post at the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of Section 2;

thence, north 00° 40' 30" east 1326.24 ft. with the east line of the southwest quarter of Section 2 to a point on the centerline of Knoxville Road;

thence, north 63° 09' 30" west 889.92 ft. with the centerline of Knoxville Road to a railroad spike, said point also being the principle place of beginning of the tract herein described;

thence, south 26° 50' 30" west 30.00 ft. to an iron pin on the south right-of-way line of Knoxville Road and the west line of Greenville Road;

thence, along the west line of Greenville Road the following courses:
south 13° 26' 43" east 222.06 ft. to an iron pin;
south 27° 59' 30" west 182.70 ft. to an iron pin;

thence, north 89° 27' 00" west 149.51 ft. to an iron pin;

thence, north 00° 33' 00" east 180.10 ft. to an iron pin;

thence, north 89° 30' 00" west 157.05 ft. to an iron pin at the south-east corner of Columbia Valley Nursing Homes, Inc. as recorded in Deed Vol. 245, page 442;

thence, north 00° 33' 00" east 397.63 ft. along the east line of Columbia Valley Nursing Homes, Inc. to a railroad spike on the centerline of Knoxville Road;

thence, south 63° 09' 30" east 390.76 ft. with the centerline of Knoxville Road to the principle place of beginning, containing a total of 3.358 acres, including for rights-of-way 0.264 acres for Knoxville Road.

Subject to all easements of record.

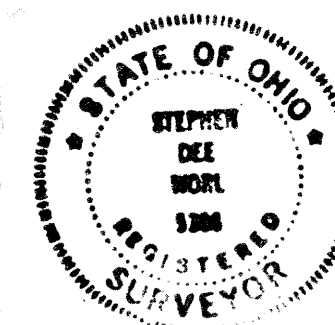

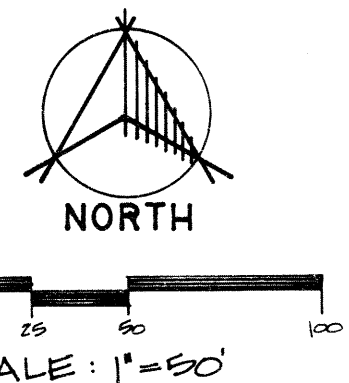
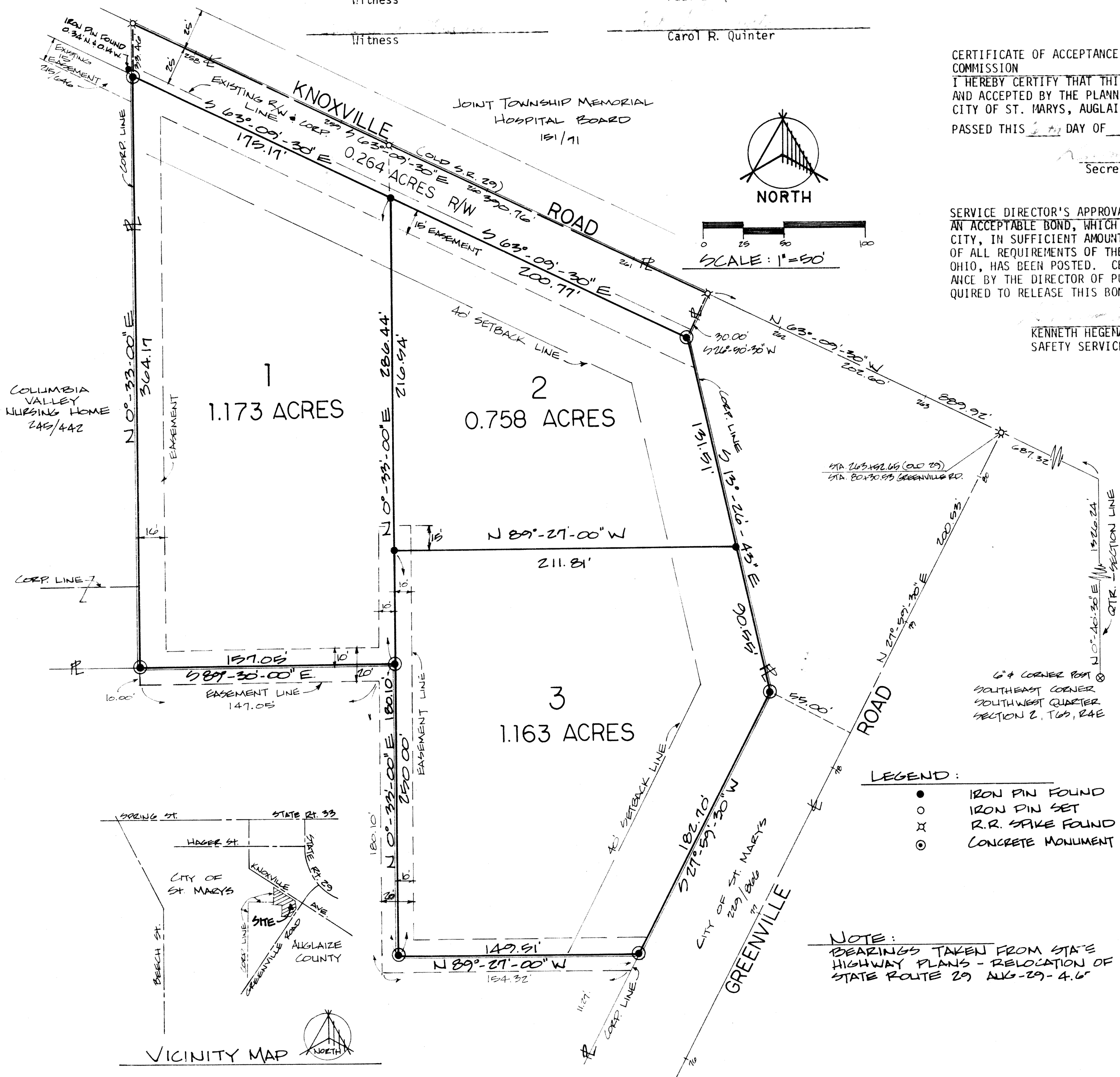
