

THIS SURVEYOR DOES NOT AGREE WITH THE SUBDIVISION'S METHOD OF DEFINING THIS PORTION OF THE R/W , HOWEVER THE MON-UMENTATION HAS BEEN LONG-EVIDENCE AVAILABLE AS A RESULT OF THE TRACKS BEING REMOVED, THEREFORE I AM ACCEPTING THE PLATS AS THE BEST REPRESENTATION OF THE ABANDONED RIW.
