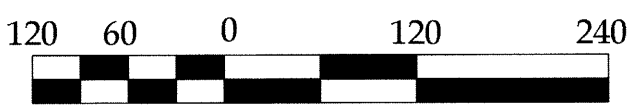

Commencing at a Monument Box at the SW corner of Section 15; thence S 89°-11'-40" E on the south line of the SW ¼ of Section 15 (centerline of Waesch Rd.), 861.46' to an existing RR Spike at the POINT OF BEGINNING, thence the following courses:

1. N 0°-48'-10" E, 568.47' to a set #5 rebar, passing an existing #5 rebar at 25.00' and an existing #5 rebar at 173.00';
2. S 89°-11'-40" E, 191.91' to a set #5 rebar;
3. S 0°-51'-48" W, 568.47' to a MAG Nail set on the South line of the SW ¼ of Section 15 (centerline of Waesch Rd.), passing a set #5 rebar at 543.47';
