SITUATE IN THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 28 TOWN 6S RANGE 5E, WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, AUGLAIZE COUNTY OHIO, BEING PART OF A TRACT OF LAND OWNED BY HOELSCHER FAMILY FARM, L.L.C. AS RECORDED IN OFFICIAL RECORD 583 PAGE 34 AND BEING MORE PARTICULLARY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Beginning at a stone in a monument box found at the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of Section 28 and the centerline of Bay Road, said stone marking the **Point of Beginning** of the tract herein described;

Thence, with the south line of northeast quarter of Section 28 and the north line of a 78.05 acre tract of land owned by David L. Feldwisch (Trustee) & Diane L. Feldwisch (Trustee) as recorded in Official Record 657 Page 553, North 89°51'36" West, 1330.51 feet to an iron pin set at the southeast quarter of a 76.710 acre tract of land owned by Kurt T. Warner & Patricia M. Warner as recorded in Official Record 722 Page 5735, passing for reference at 20.00 feet the west right of way line of Bay Road;

Thence, with the east line of said 76.710 acre tract, North 01°19'01" East, 1044.15 feet to an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found in the south line of a 69.527 acre tract of land owned by Scott A. Bambauer (Trustee) & Teresa I. Bambauer (Trustee) as recorded in Official Record 726 Page 3926;

Thence, with the lines of said 69.725 acre tract, the following 5 courses:

- 1. South 89°51'07" East, 380.61 feet to a wood post;
- 2. North 14°07'56" East, 159.05 feet to an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found;
- 3. South 88°42'01" East, 346.52 feet to an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found;
- 4. South 00°55'57" West, 752.31 feet to an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found;
- 5. South 89°39'19" East, 563.34 feet to a Mag Nail found in the east line of the northeast quarter of Section 28 and the centerline of Bay Road, passing for reference at 543.34 feet an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found in the west right of way line of Bay Road;

Thence, with the east line of the northeast quarter of Section 28 and the centerline of Bay Road, South 01°22'16" West, 437.05 feet to the **Point of Beginning**, containing 25.292 acres more or less of which 0.201 acres lie in the right of way of Bay Road and being subject to all legal rights of way, easements, agreements and restrictions of record.

Basis of bearings is based on the Ohio Department of Transportation V.R.S., Ohio State Plane North Zone 3401, NAD 83(2011ADJ). The Official Records and Deed Volumes are all recorded in the County Recorder's Office. Pins noted as set are 5/8" x 30" re-bar with pink plastic caps stamped "Lock-Two 7988".
