

Fryburgh surveyed July 1st 1837

The Town of Fryburgh is laid off on the South part of North East quarter of the South East quarter of section fifteen Town six South, Range six East in Allen County

Lots numbered 15, 16 & 41 are each 64 feet wide and 8 rods long, The Lots bordering on the Creek are of the dimensions noted on the plat in rods and links. The other Lots are each 4 rods wide and 8 rods long, Van, Buren, Sidney & Scites Streets are each 60 feet wide, Schenckel, Walnut & Spring Streets are each 3 rods wide the alleys are each 12 feet wide, and they all cross each other at right angles, & run with the Cardinal points. A monument is planted at the South East corner of Lot No 1
