

Sec. 2. That the Main street in said town shall be seventy-two feet wide, and Main cross street, and the North and South streets each, sixty-six feet wide, as specified in said survey and plat.

Sec. 3. The said town of Stalloostown shall hereafter be known and called by the name of Minster: *Provided*, That nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to affect the titles or rights of any person or persons acquired under its former name.

AN ACT

To establish and admit to record, a certain Survey of the town of Stalloostown, in Mercer county, and to change its name to Minster.

Sec. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio*, That the survey and plat of the town of Stalloostown, in Mercer county, Ohio, made by Justin Hamilton, county surveyor of said county, be admitted to record by the recorder of said county. And that said survey and plat shall be hereafter taken and received as the only true survey and plat of said town.

Description of Minster

Minster, is laid out on the S. West Quarter, of sec 26. the S. East Quarter, of section 27. the N. E. quarter of sec 34, and the N. W. quarter of section 35. T. 7 S. of Range 4. E. in the County of Mercer.

This Town, by agreement of the Germantown Company by whom the Land was purchased, was divided into 144 Shares. each Share extending East or West, from main Street, to the boundary of the Town, through an equal 12th part of each square, marked, b. d. e. f. g. h. i. k. the Town is laid off into 60. squares. the four center ones contain each eighteen lots exclusive of those given for public uses, and hereafter described. The other squares, are intended to be laid off into 24 lots, each, with a 16 feet alley, running North and South through the center of the square. That part of the Town, between Switzer, Main, and Lüneburg Streets, has been fully laid out into lots, in pursuance of the above plans. The corners of lots, have also been set on the East side, of Switzer and West side of Lüneburg Streets, the remainder of the Town, is laid off into squares, and the lines through those squares, serve only to show the Shares as extending back, from Main Street. and the letters mark the lots and intended lots in each share, the lots are 219⁷/₂ feet long. and 68⁷/₂ feet wide, except those on the West, and East side of the North half, of the town which will when laid off, be fractional the lots however, between the public lots, and main Street, are 68⁷/₂ feet by 34⁵/₂ feet long. the public lots, are as follows, the one marked A. Catholic Church, lot B. Catholic School House lot C. Protestant Church lot D. Protestant School house lot E. E. Market Place, F. Court House lot G. Town hall lot. These public lots, are each

60 feet by 181 $\frac{3}{4}$ feet. except the market place which is 60 feet by 362 feet. These lots are bounded on two sides by the following streets, marked thus

1. Clay Street.
2. Washington Street.
3. Jackson Street.
4. Jefferson Street.
5. Monroe Street.
6. Madison Street.
7. Rosmont Street.
8. Adams Street.

and these streets are each 50 feet wide. The width of the other streets, alleys, and squares will be found marked in feet on the plat. The Center of Main Street at the North and South End thereof, is five links East of the quarter section Corner, and at the Center of the Town, 5 links west of the section Corner. The line between Secs. 26 & 35. and 27 & 34. is 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet, south of the Center of Fourth Street. Stones have been planted, at the N.E. Corner of Share No. 72. the N.W. Corner of Share No. 73. at the N.E. Corner of Share No. 36 also at the N.W. corner of Market place, and S.W. corner of Catholic Church lot. The North and South Streets, are laid out on a variation of 3° 25' E. & West Streets, 4° 05' Ohio & Paris Streets, however a little from that variation. All of which is hereby certified to be correct, done October 1836.
