

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE for ALBERT MESCHER

The following tract of land is part of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 25, Jackson Township, Tier 7 South, Range 4 East, with respect to the First Principal Meridian, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows:


Commencing at a Railroad Spike in the intersection of State Route 363 and State Route 119, also being the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of

Section 25, Jackson Township, Auglaize County, Ohio;
thence NS9°50°W along the centerline of State Route 119, also being the south
Section line of Section 25, of said Township, a distance of 505.09 feet to a Railroad Spike, which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING;

thence continuing N89°50'W a distance of 160.0 feet to a Railroad Spike; thence N00°05'E a distance of 272.25 feet to an iron pin; thence SS9°50'E a distance of 160.0 feet to an iron pin;

thence S00°03'W a distance of 272.25 feet to a Railroad Spike which was the PLACE OF BEGINNING, passing an iron pin at 242.25 feet on the north right-of-way line of State Route 119.

The above tract of land contains 1.0 acre including 0.11 acre already dedicated for highway purposes.
