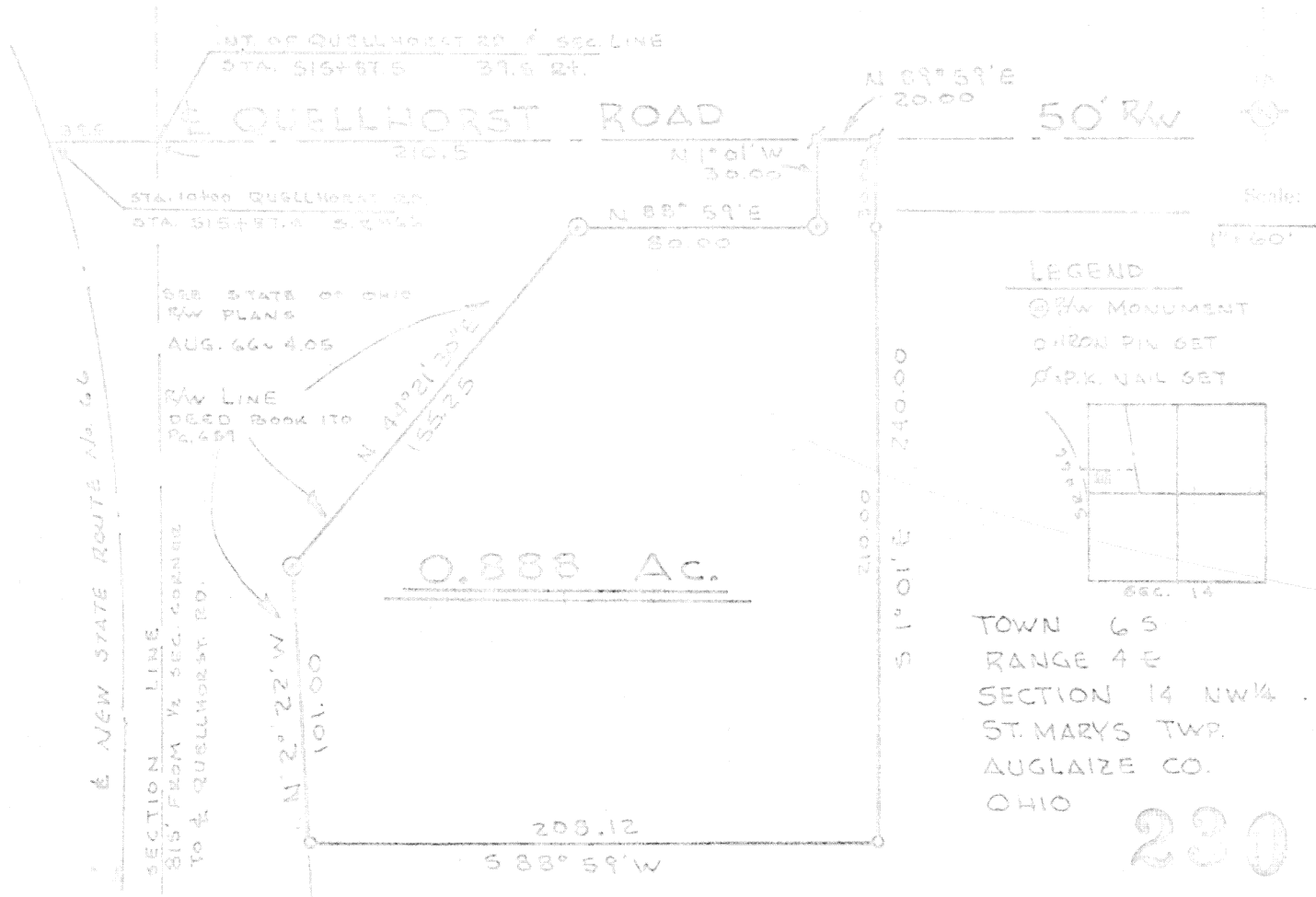

Thence East with the center of Quellhorst Road, 240.5 feet to a P.K. nail and PLACE OF BEGINNING for tract of land herein described.

Thence North 89° 59' East, 20.00 feet to a P.K. nail.

Thence South 1° 01' East, 240.00 feet to an iron pin.

Thence South 88° 59' West, 102.12 feet to an iron pin on the East right-of-way line of S.R. # 66.

Thence North 2° 22' West with said right-of-way, 101.00 feet to a concrete monument.

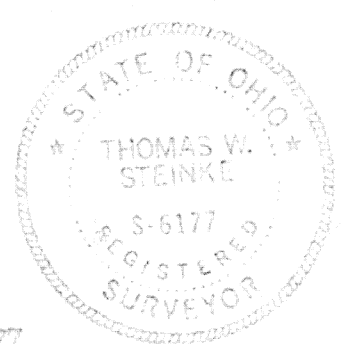
Thence North 49° 21' 30" East with said right-of-way, 155.25 feet to a concrete monument.
