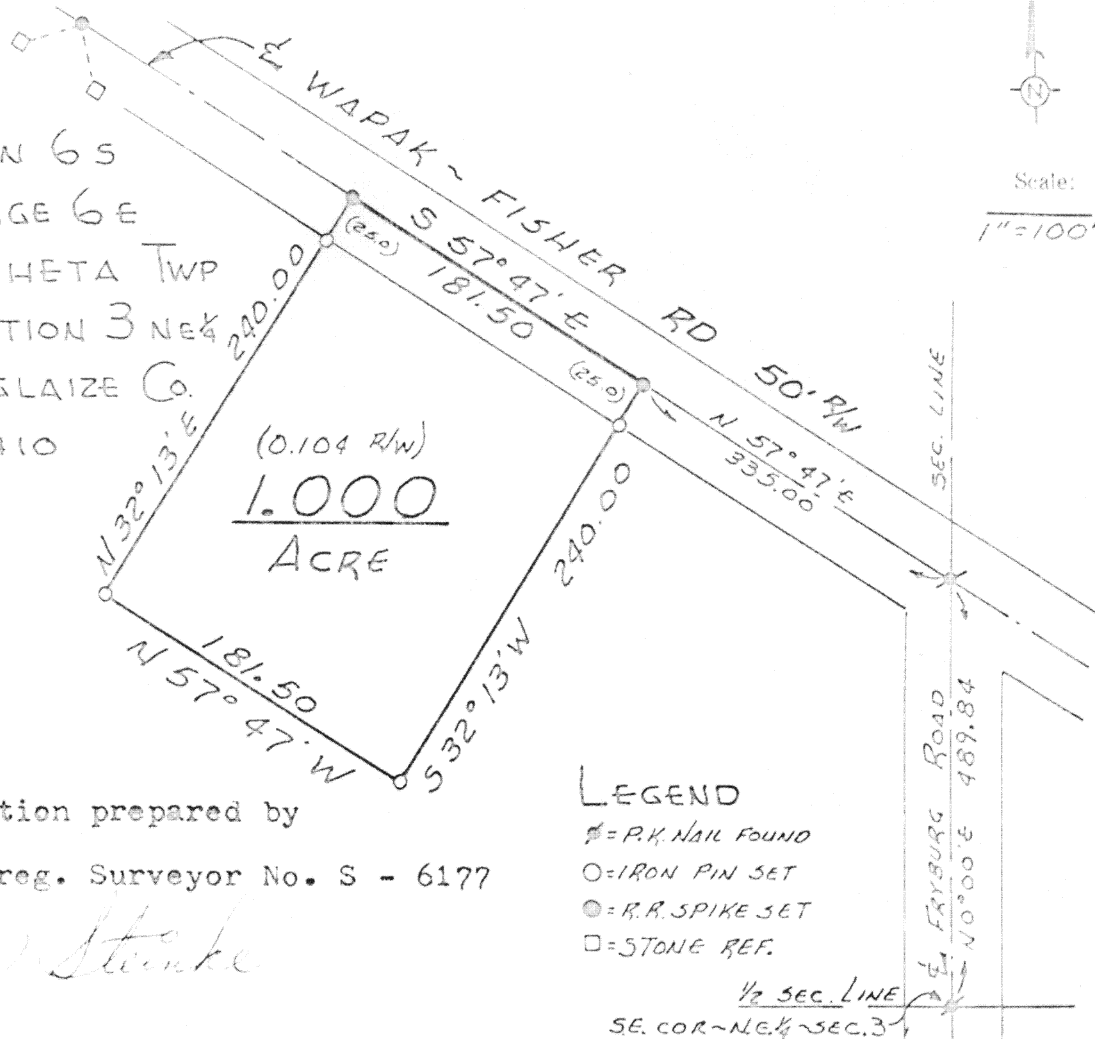
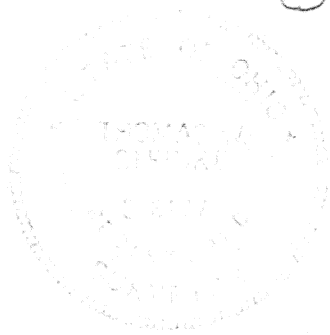

Being 1.000 Acres in the North-East quarter of Section 3, Town 6 S, Range 6 E, Pusheta Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at a P.K. nail at the South-East corner of the North-East quarter of Section 3, Thence North 0° 00' East with the East line of Section 3, 489.84 feet to a P.K. nail at the center line intersection of Fryburg Road and Wapak-Fisher Road. Thence North 57° 47' East with the center line of Wapak-Fisher Road, 335.00 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described. Thence South 32° 13' West, 240.00 feet to an iron pin. Thence North 57° 47' West, 181.50 feet to an iron pin. Thence North 32° 13' East, 240.00 feet to a railroad spike. Thence South 57° 47' East with the center of Wapak-Fisher Rd., 181.50 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING. Containing 1.000 Ac. (0.104 Ac. in road R/W) Wapak-Fisher Road being a total 50' R/W.
