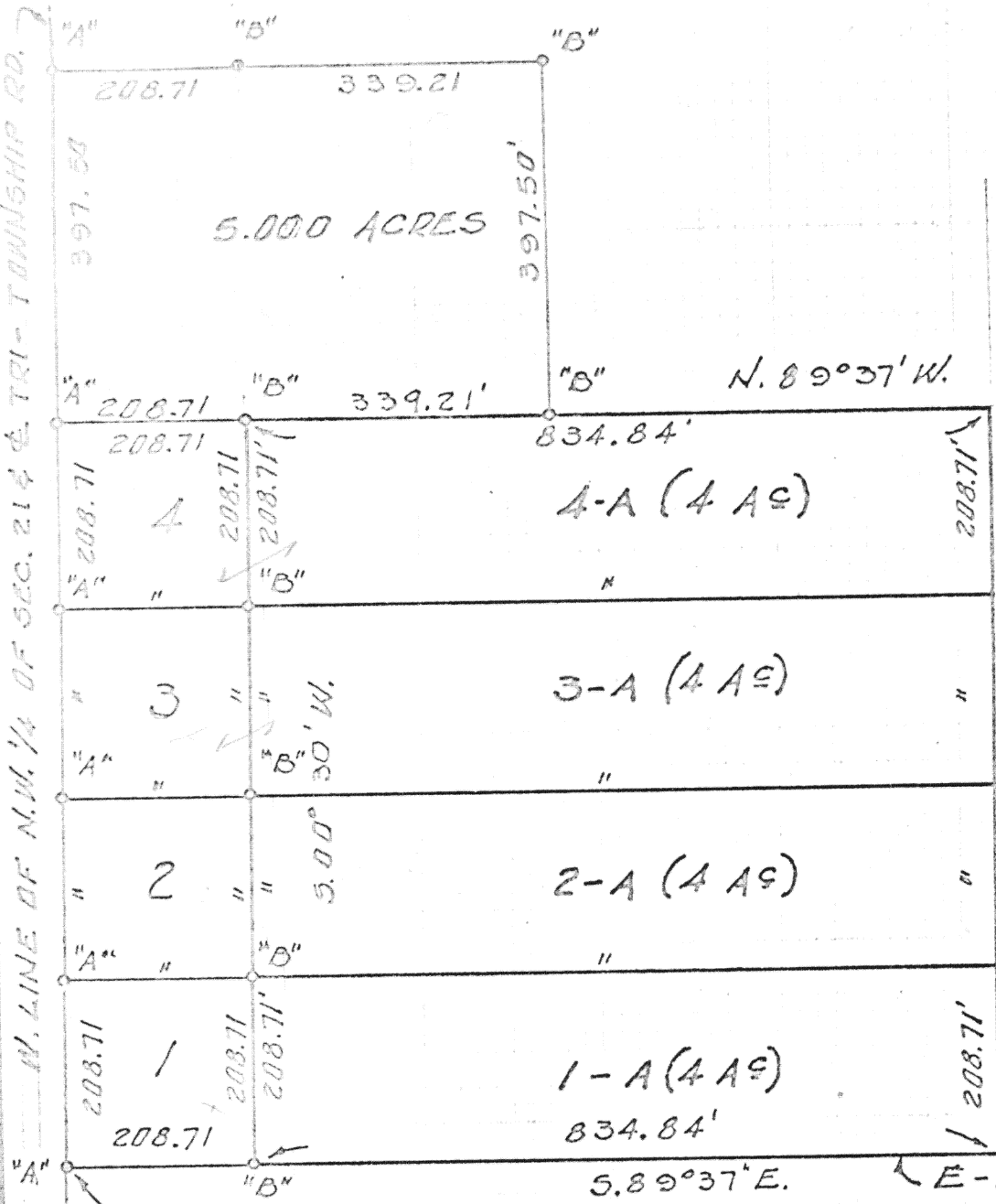


W. LINE OF N.W. 1/4 OF SEC. 21 & E. TRI-TOWNSHIP RD.

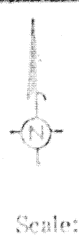

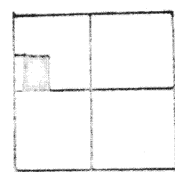

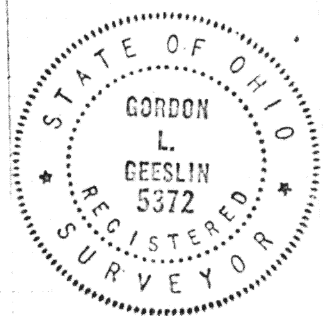


LEGEND

DESCRIPTION FOR EASEMENT 3-A

Being a parcel of land situated in St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the northwest quarter of Section 21, Township 6 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a railroad spike at the west quarter point of said Section 21-

Thence, south $89^{\circ}37'$ east, along the east-west Half Section line of said Section 21, a distance of two hundred eight and $71/100$ (208.71) feet to a point-

Thence, north $00^{\circ}30'$ east, a distance of four hundred seventeen and $42/100$ (417.42) feet to an iron bar at the southeast corner of tract "three" as shown on plat 71-5653 by Clayton Stimmel, Registered Surveyor 4906. Said point being the place of beginning for the herein described easement-

Thence, continuing north $00^{\circ}30'$ east, along the east line of said tract "three", a distance of two hundred eight and $71/100$ (208.71) feet to an iron bar at the northeast corner thereof-

Thence, south $89^{\circ}37'$ east, a distance of eight hundred thirty-four and $84/100$ (834.84) feet to a point-

Thence, south $00^{\circ}30'$ west, a distance of two hundred eight and $71/100$ (208.71) feet to a point-

Thence, north $89^{\circ}37'$ west, a distance of eight hundred thirty-four and $84/100$ (834.84) feet to the place of beginning.
