


TOWN 6-5

Being 1.000 Acres located in the North-East quarter of Section 24, T-6-S, R-5-E, Washington Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike located at the South-West corner of the North-East quarter of Section 24, also being the center line intersection of Headapohl Road T.R.# 106 and Kohler Road C.R.# 125.

Thence North 89° 00' East with the center of T.R.# 106 and the east-west half section line of Section 24, a distance of 358.72 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Thence continuing North 89° 00' East with said center line and half section line, a distance of 170.00 feet to a railroad spike. Thence North 01° 00' West, a distance of 256.24 feet to an iron pin. Thence South 89° 00' West, a distance of 170.00 feet to an iron pin. Thence South 01° 00' East, a distance of 256.24 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING. Containing in all 1.000 acres and being subject to 0.1 Ac. in road R/W.
