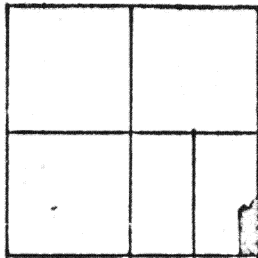


LOCATION SKETCH

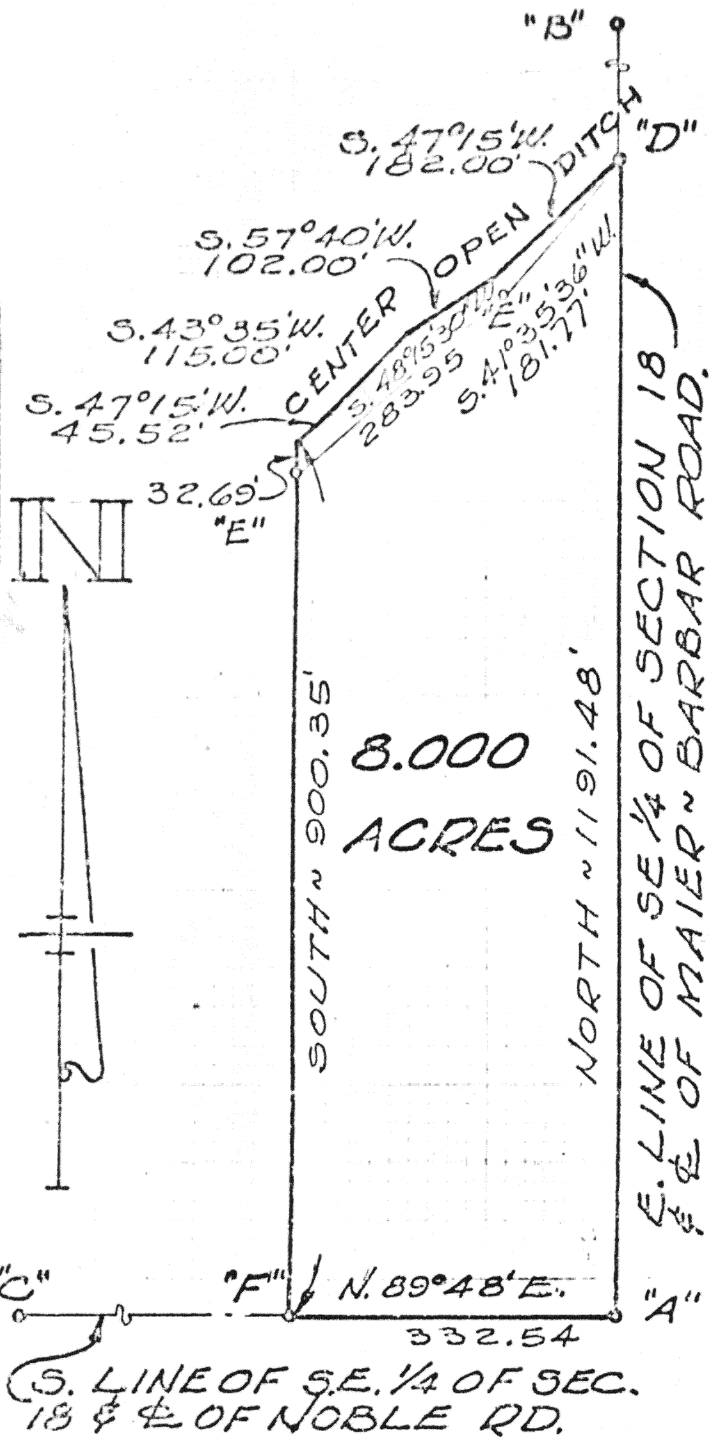

SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in Noble Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the east half of the southeast quarter of Section 18, Town 5 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Scale: _____

Beginning at the corner stone at the southeast corner of said Section 18-

Thence, north, along the east line of the southeast quarter of said Section 18 and the centerline of Maier-Barber Road, a distance of one thousand one hundred ninety-one and 48/100 (1191.48) feet to a mine spike-

Thence, southwesterly, along the center of an open ditch the following bearings and distances:

south 47°15' west - 182.00 feet

south 57°40' west - 102.00 feet

south 43°35' west - 115.00 feet

south 47°15' west - 45.52 feet-

Thence, leaving said open ditch, south, nine hundred and 35/100 (900.35) feet to a railroad spike in the south line of the southeast quarter of said Section 18 and the centerline of Noble Road-

Thence, north 89°48' east, along said south line of the southeast quarter of Section 18 and the centerline of Noble Road, a distance of three hundred thirty-two and 54/100 (332.54) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 8.000 acres of land more or less.

Subject to all easements and right-of-way of record.

The east line of the southeast quarter of Section 18 was assumed to bear north-south. All other bearings were calculated from angles turned.

Reference is made to a survey of this area by Gordon L. Geeslin, Registered Surveyor 5372, dated November 18, 1976, on file in the County Engineer's Office.
