

Surveyors Description

The following described tract of land is part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, Town 5 South, Range 7 East, Union Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows. The PLACE OF BEGINNING being a railroad spike at the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, Union Township (Railroad spike being in the center of State Route 67)

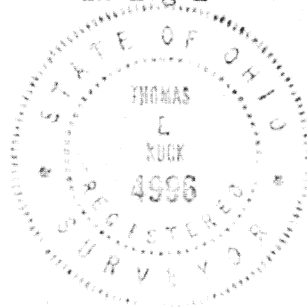
Thence South 87° 03' East along the center of State Route 67, 348.00 feet to a capped nail.

Thence South 0° 08' West (passing through a 3" steel angle iron post set at 29.10 feet) 300.00 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence North 87° 03' West, 347.30 feet to an iron pipe set on the West line of Section 22, Union Township.

Thence North along the West line of Section 22, Union Township (passing through a steel angle iron post set at 269.85 feet) 300.00 feet to the railroad spike at the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, Union Township, which was the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The above described tract of land contains 2.391 acres more or less subject to 0.240 acres dedicated to the public for highway purposes and to all legal easements of record.
