DESCRIPTION OF 3.041 ACRES

Being part of the south-east quarter of Section 1, Town 6-S, Range 4-E, St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike at the center line intersection of Washington Pike and Barrington Road, said point being made reference to by a survey recorded in Deed Book 230, Page 802 and being the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described.

Thence S 89° 24' E, 178.92 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence N 04° 09' E, 500.79 feet to the center of a creek, passing through an iron pipe for reference at 472.79 feet.

Thence S 83° 45' 30" W with the center of said creek, a distance of 350.38 feet to a railroad spike set in the center of a wood floor bridge on Barrington Road.

Thence S 02° 10' 30" E, 38.0 feet to a P.K. nail.

Thence south with said road along a curve with a chord of 118.62 feet a length of 119.88 feet and a radius of 391.72 feet to a P.K. nail.

Thence S 19° 45' 30" E, a distance of 324.04 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 3.041 Acres and being subject to all legal easements and R/W of record.
