DESCRIPTION OF 1.776 ACRES

106 PARK ST. WAPAKONETA, OHIO 45895

Being 1.776 Acres located in the north-west quarter of Section 28, T-5-S, R-6-E, Duchouquet Township, Auglaize County, Chio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the east-west half section line of Section 28 and the center of C.R.# 25-A, said point being the same as called for in D.B. 210, Pg.230.

Thence north-easterly with the center of C.R.# 25-A, a distance of 674.1 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described.

Thence continuing north-east with said center line, a distance of 189.74 feet to a P.K. nail found at the corner of D.B. 188, Pg. 124.

Thence north-west along the south-west line of said D.B. and Pg. with an interior angle of 93° 45°, a distance of 397.0 feet to an iron pipe found. Thence south-west along a line commonly agreed upon by D.B. 210, Pg. 230 and D.B. 158, Pg. 601 with an interior angle of 91° 49° 40°, a distance of 101.52 feet to a 3° angle corner post.

Thence south-east along a line agreed upon by said parties with an interior angle of 87° 53', a distance of 415.50 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING, making an interior angle with the starting point of 86° 32' 20" Containing in all 1.776 Acres and being subject to all legal easements and rights-of-way of record.

The above described porperty is a description of all the lands described in D.B. 158, Pg. 601, after a common agreement upon property lines. Survey and description prepared by Thomas W. Steinke, registered surveyor # 6177 and recorded in Survey Book "C" Page 92 of the Auglaize County Survey Records.
