

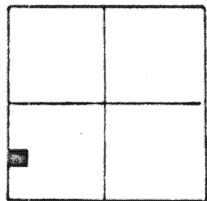

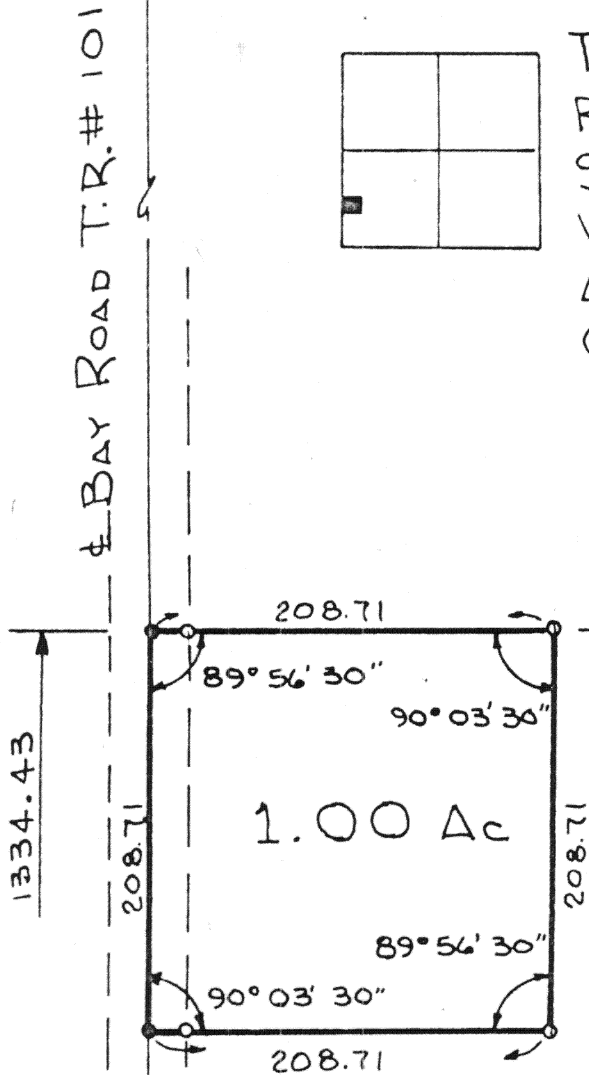

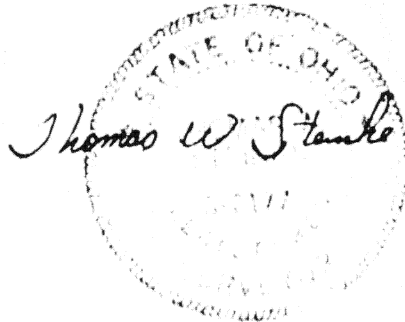

and the west line of Section 27, 1334.43 feet north of the south-west corner
of Section 27 and the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein
described.

208.71 feet to an iron pipe set, passing through an iron pipe at 20.0 feet.

 $89^{\circ} 56' 30''$.
