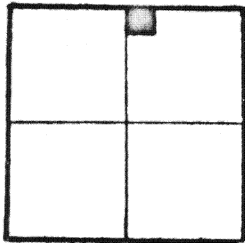
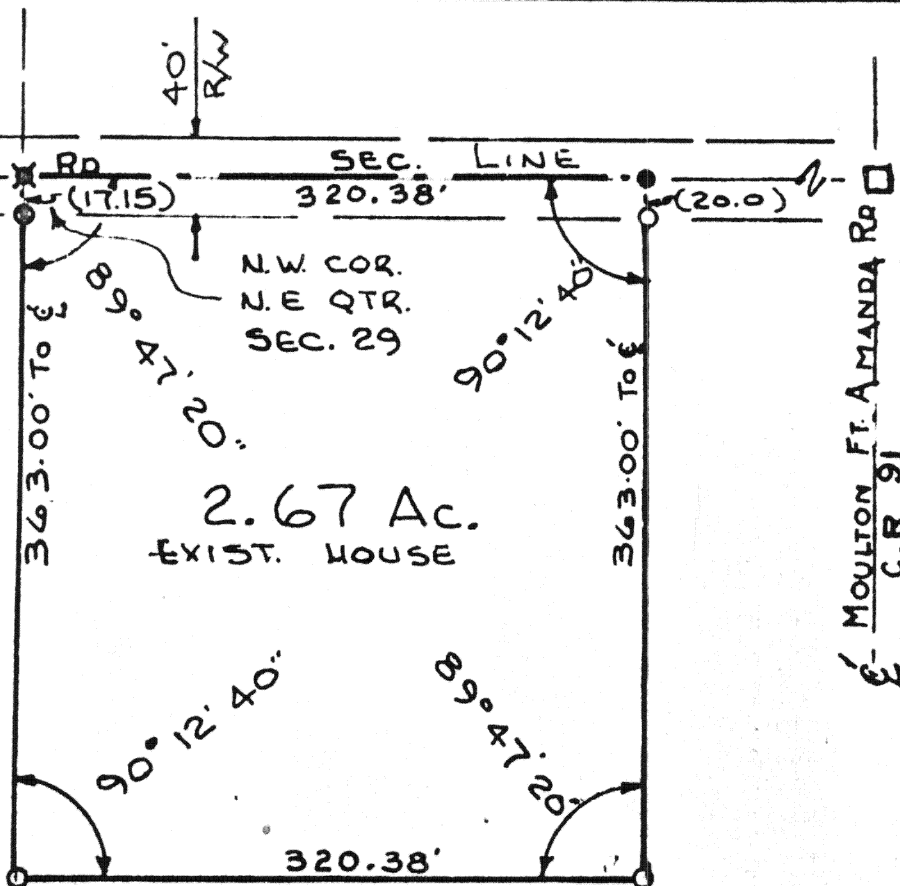


BURNFIELD

DESCRIPTION OF 2.67 ACRES

Bring 2.67 Acres located in the north-east quarter of Section 29, Town 4-S, Range 5-E, Logan Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at the north-west corner of the north-east quarter of Section 29 and the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described

Thence east with the north line of Section 29 and the center of Burnfield Road P.R.# 220, a distance of 320.38 feet to a railroad spike.

Thence south with an interior angle of $90^{\circ} 12' 40''$, a distance of 363.00 feet to an iron pipe, passing through an iron pipe at 20.0 feet.

Thence west with an interior angle of $89^{\circ} 47' 20''$, a distance of 320.38 feet to an iron pipe in the north-south half section line of Section 29.

Thence north with an interior angle of $90^{\circ} 12' 40''$, along said half section line, a distance of 363.00 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING, passing through a conc. corner post at 345.85 feet.

Containing in all 2.67 Acres and being subject to all legal easements and rights-of-way of record.
