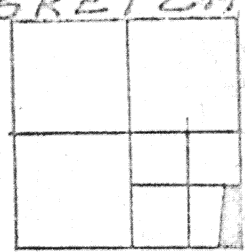

SKETCH



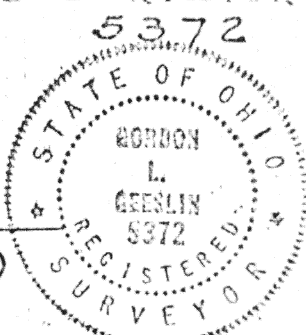

SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 28, Township 6 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a railroad spike at the southeast corner of said Section 28-

Thence, north $00^{\circ}40.5'$ west, along the east line of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said Section 28, a distance of seven hundred thirteen and $40/100$ (713.40) feet to a point. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument-

Thence, continuing north $00^{\circ}40.5'$ west, along the last described line, a distance of six hundred nine and $61/100$ (609.61) feet to a $5/8$ inch iron bar at the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said Section 28-

Thence, south $89^{\circ}00'$ west, along the north line of said southeast quarter of the southeast quarter, a distance of three hundred twenty-nine and $51/100$ (329.51) feet to a railroad spike in the centerline of County Route 66-A-

Thence, south $04^{\circ}31.9'$ west, along the centerline of said County Route 66-A, a distance of six hundred twelve and $45/100$ (612.45) feet to a point-

Thence, north $89^{\circ}00'$ east, a distance of three hundred eighty-five and $09/100$ (385.09) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 5.000 acres of land more or less.

Subject to all easements and right-of-way of record.

The centerline of County Route 66-A was assumed to bear south $04^{\circ}31.9'$ west. All other bearings were calculated from angles turned.
