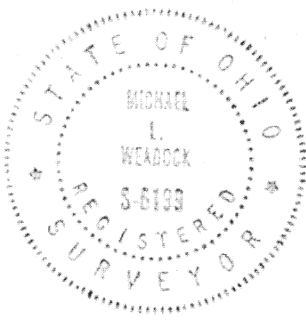
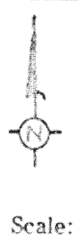
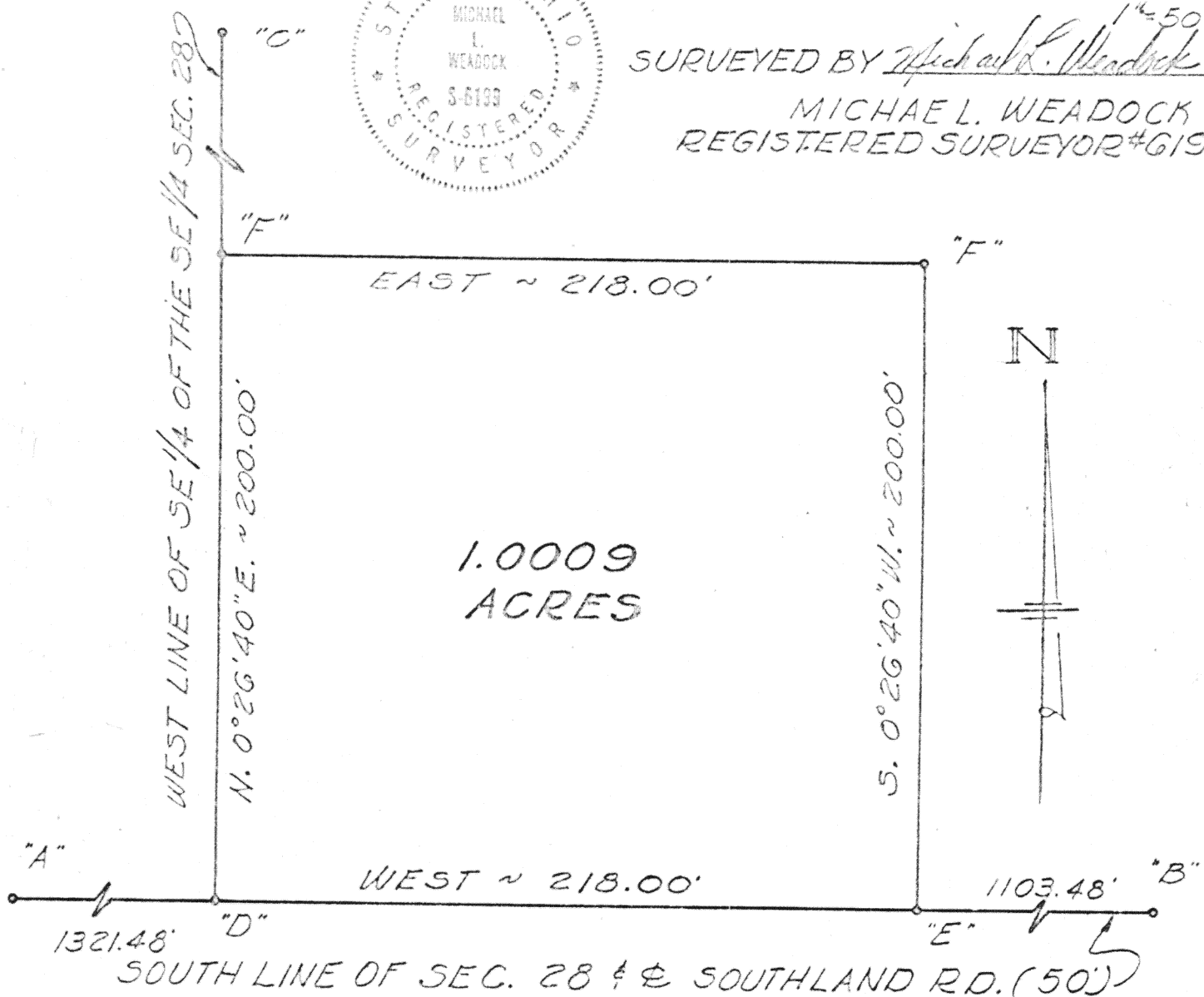

SURVEY DESCRIPTION



Scale: _____

Being a parcel of land situated in St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 28, Township 6 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a railroad spike at the south quarter post of Section 28;

Thence, East, along the south line of Section 28 and the centerline of Southland Road, a distance of one thousand three hundred twenty-one and 48/100 (1321.48) feet to a railroad spike, said point being the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 28, and the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument;

Thence, North 0 26'40" East, along the west line of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said Section 28, a distance of two hundred and 00/100 (200.00) feet to a 5/8" iron bar;

Thence, East, parallel with the south line of the southeast quarter of said Section 28, a distance of two hundred eighteen and 00/100 (218.00) feet to a 5/8" iron bar:

Thence, South 0 26'40" West, parallel to the west line of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said Section 28, a distance of two hundred and 00/100 (200.00) feet to a railroad spike, said point being on the south line of Section 28 and the centerline of Southland Road;

Thence, West, along the south line of Section 28 and the centerline of Southland Road, a distance of two hundred eighteen and 00/100 (218.00) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 1.0009 acres of land more or less.

Subject to all easements and rights-of-way of record.

The south line of Section 28 (centerline of Southland Road) was assumed to bear East-West. All other bearings were calculated from angles turned.
