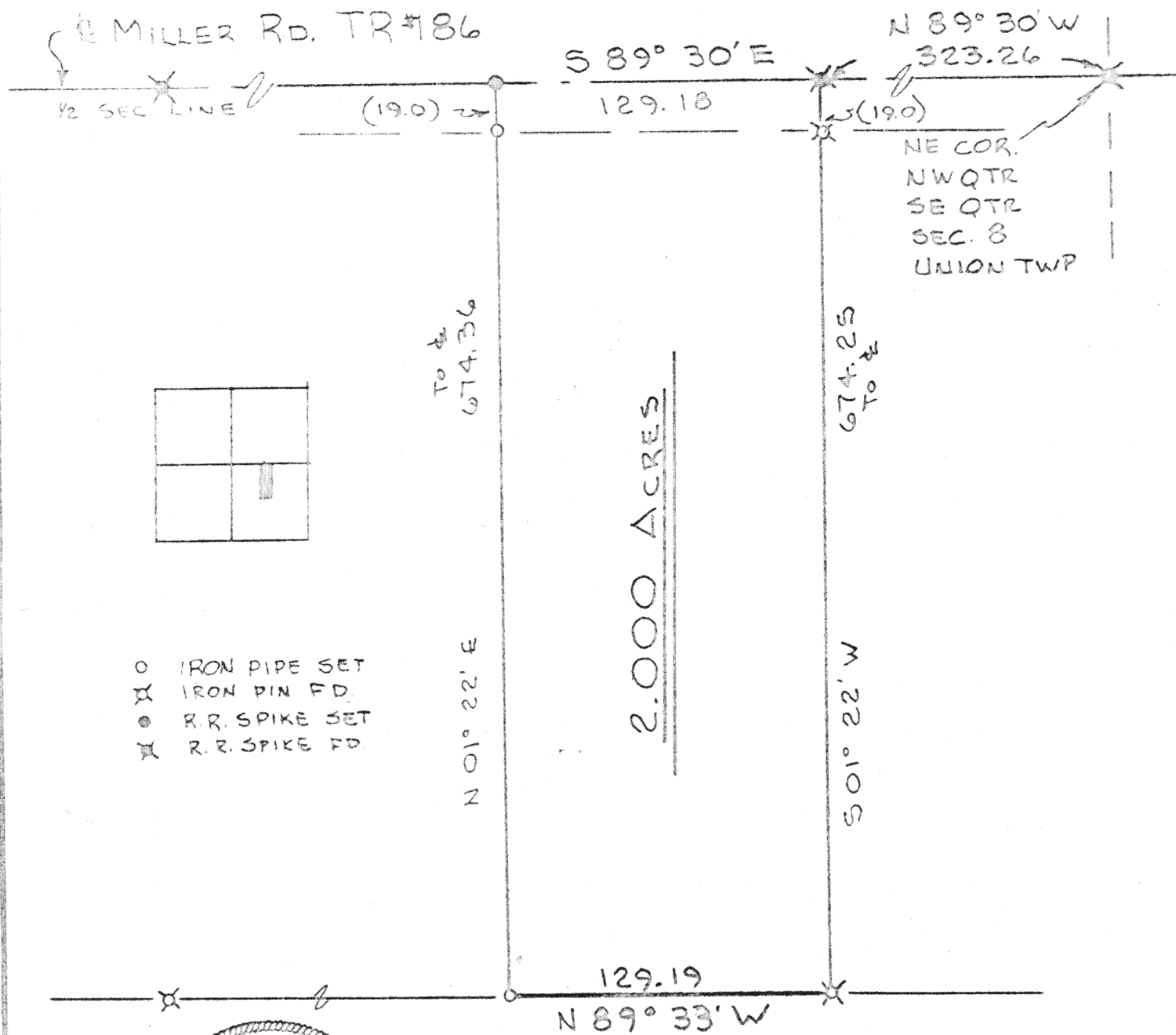


SECTION TIE & REFERENCE POINTS

Description of 2.000 Acres
From Myron Shaw to Robert Wolson

Being 2.000 Acres located in the south-east quarter of Section 8, Town 5-S, Range 7-E, Union Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at the north-east corner of the north-west quarter of the south-east quarter of Section 8.

Thence North $89^{\circ} 30'$ West along the center line of Miller Road # 186 and the half section line of Section 8, a distance of 323.26 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING. *674.25* *see ORV06120 Pg. 466*

Thence South $01^{\circ} 22'$ West, a distance of 675.25 feet to an iron pin, passing through an iron pin at 19.0 feet.

Thence North $89^{\circ} 33'$ West, a distance of 129.19 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence North $01^{\circ} 22'$ East, a distance of 674.36 feet to a railroad spike in the center of Miller Road # 186, passing through an iron pipe at 155.36 feet.

Thence South $89^{\circ} 30'$ East with said center line and half section line, a distance of 129.18 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 2.000 Acres and being subject to all legal easements and R/W of record.
