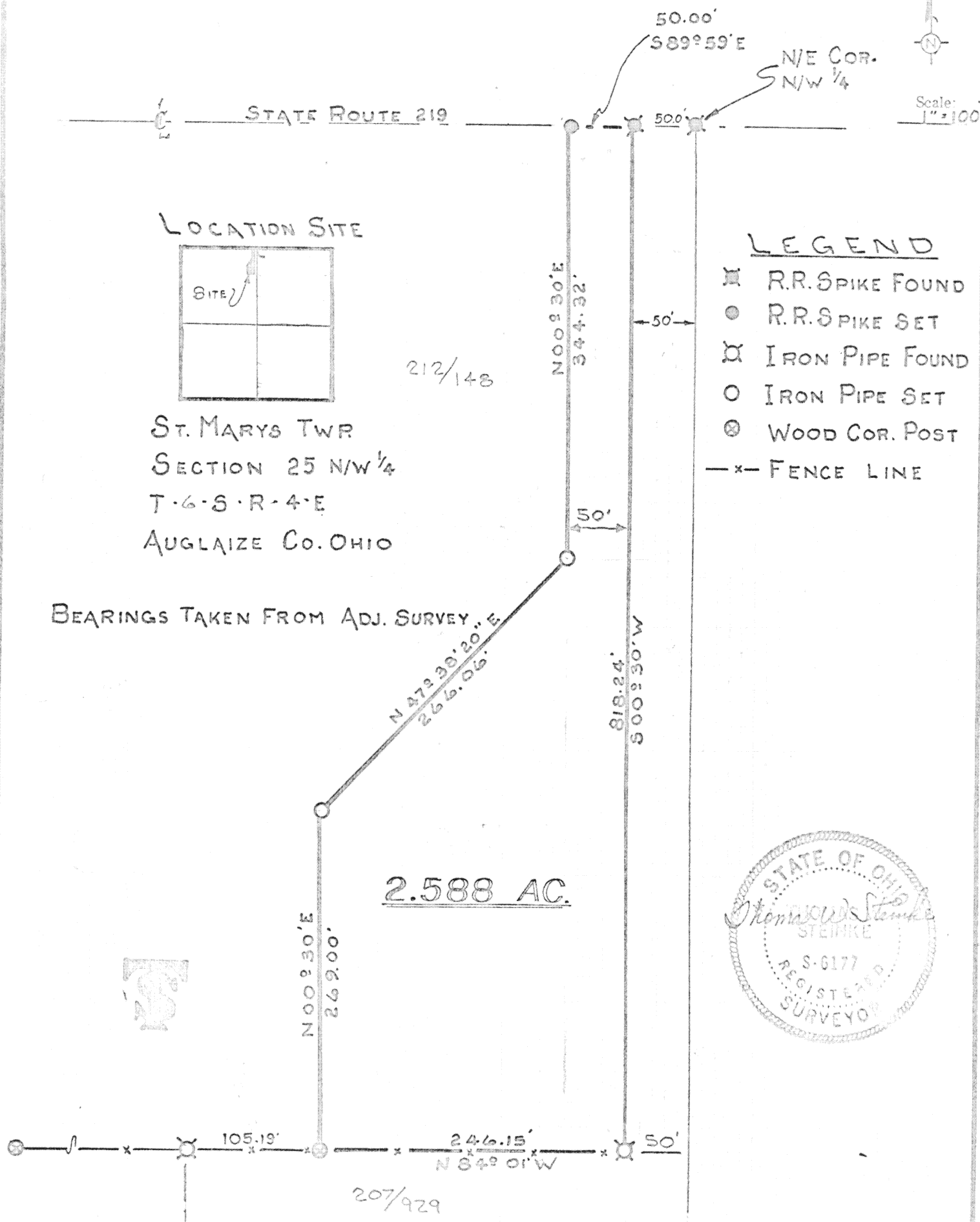

DESCRIPTION OF 2.588 ACRES

Being 2.588 Acres located in the north-west quarter of Section 25, Town 6-S, Range 4-E, St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike at the north-east corner of the north-west quarter of Section 25, said point being the center line of State Route # 219.

Thence west with the center line of State Route # 219 and the north line of Section 25 North $89^{\circ} 59'$ West, a distance of 50.00 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described.

Thence South $00^{\circ} 30'$ West, parallel with the east line of said quarter section, a distance of 818.24 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence North $84^{\circ} 01'$ ^{WEST}, a distance of 246.15 feet to a wood corner post.

Thence North $00^{\circ} 30'$ East, a distance of 269.00 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence North $47^{\circ} 38' 20''$ East, a distance of 266.06 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence North $00^{\circ} 30'$ East, a distance of 344.32 feet to a railroad spike in the north line of Section 25 and the center of State Route # 219.

Thence South $89^{\circ} 59'$ East with said center line and section line, a distance of 50.00 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING.
