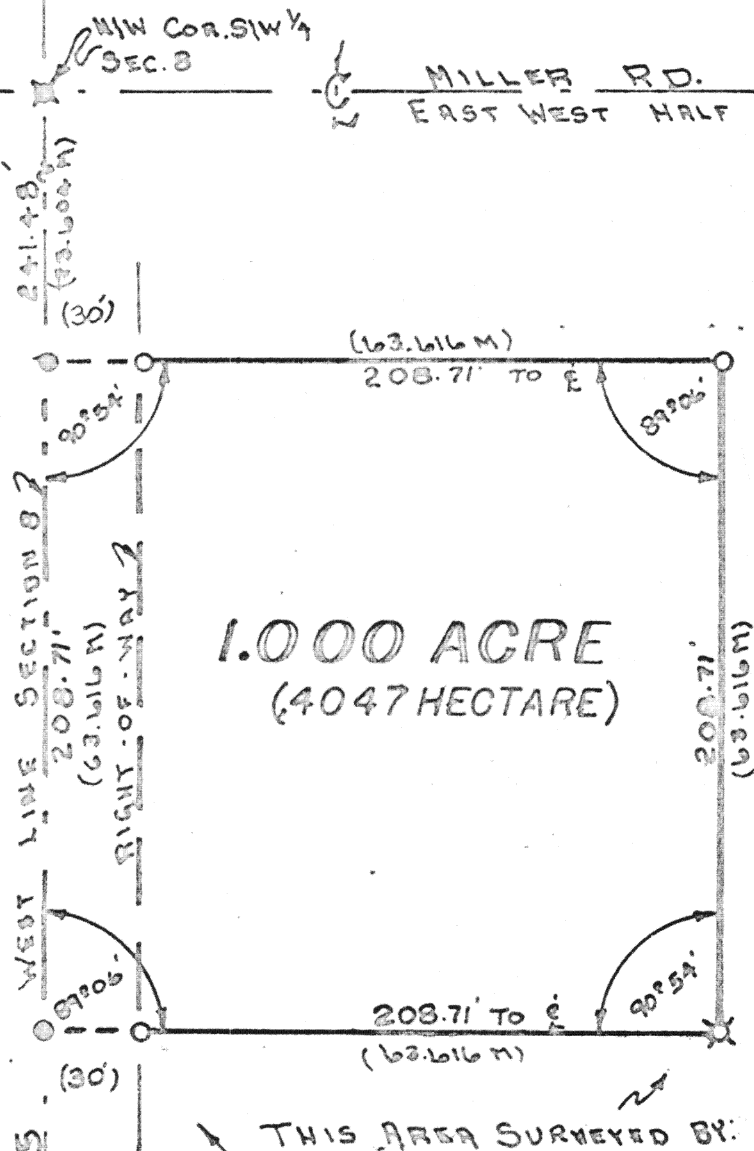


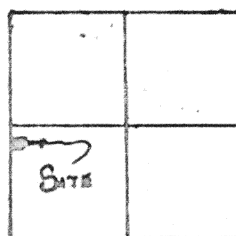

Being 1.000 Acre located in the south-west quarter of Section 8, Town 5-S, Range 7-E, Union Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike found at the north-west corner of the south-west quarter of Section 8.

Thence south with the west line of Section 8 and the center line of State Route # 65, a distance of 241.48 feet (73.604 Meters) to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described.

Thence continuing south with said center line and section line, a distance of 208.71 feet (63.616 Meters) to a railroad spike.

Thence east with an interior angle of $89^{\circ} 06'$, a distance of 208.71 feet (63.616 Meters) to an iron bar found, passing through an iron pipe at 30.0 feet (9.144 Meters)

Thence north with an interior angle of $90^{\circ} 54'$, a distance of 208.71 feet (63.616 Meters) to an iron pipe.

Thence west with an interior angle of $89^{\circ} 06'$, a distance of 208.71 feet (63.616 Meters) to a railroad spike in the center line of S.R. # 65 and the PLACE OF BEGINNING passing through an iron pipe at 178.71 feet (54.471 Meters).

Containing in all 1.000 Acre (0.4047 Hectare) and being subject to 0.14 Acre in road right-of-way.
