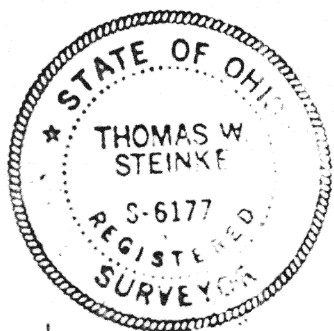


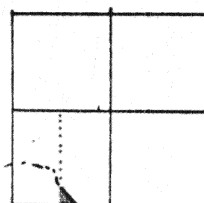

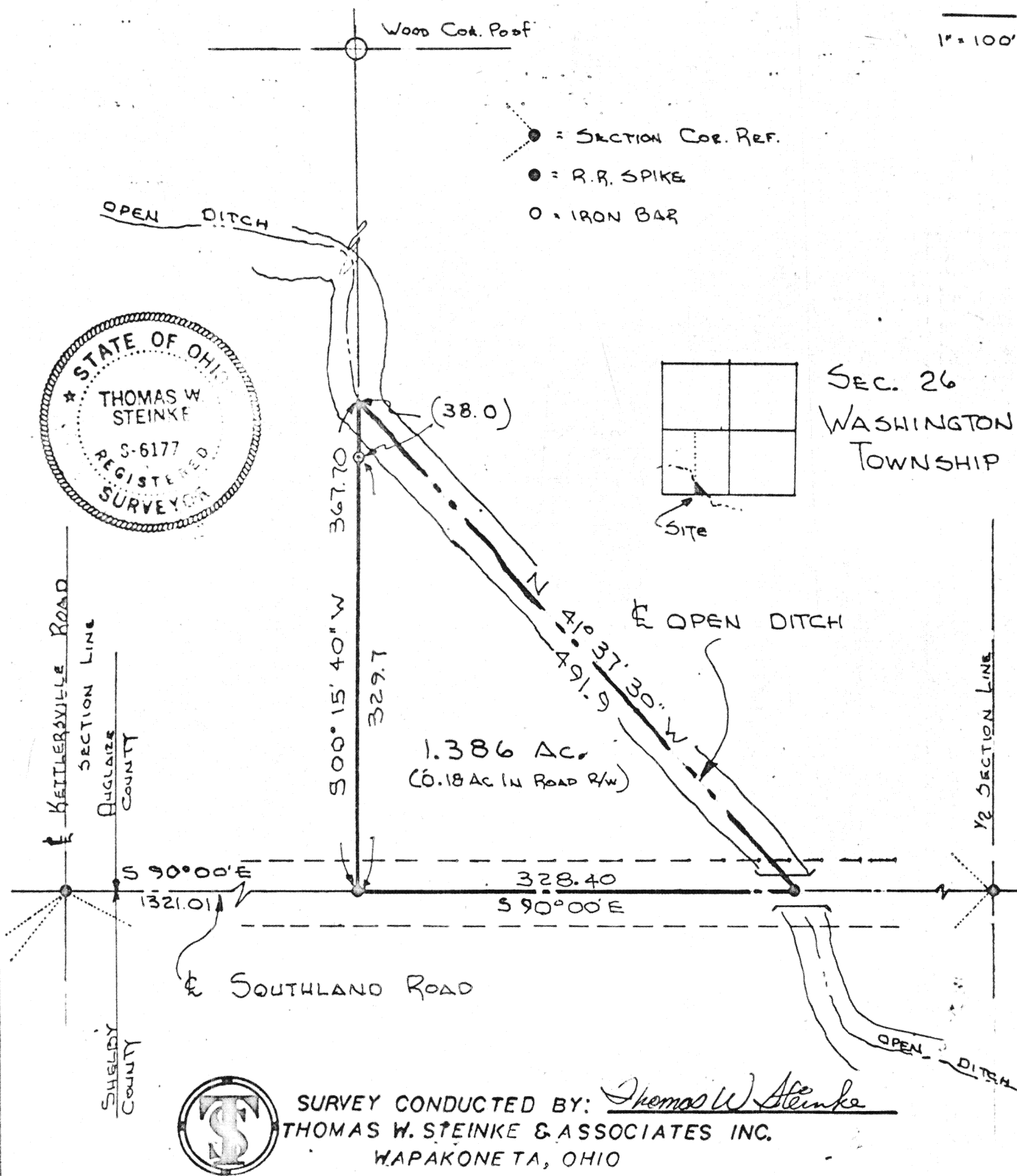

Being 1.386 Acres located in the south-west quarter of Section 26, Town 6-S, Range 5-E, Washington Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike located at the south-west corner of Section 26.

Thence South $90^{\circ} 00'$ East with the south line of Section 26 and the center line of the County Line Road, a distance of 1321.01 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described.

Thence continuing South $90^{\circ} 00'$ East, a distance of 328.40 feet to a railroad spike in the center of a bridge over an open ditch.

Thence North $41^{\circ} 37' 30''$ West with the center of said open ditch, a distance of 491.90 feet to a point in the quarter section line, referenced by an iron bar set South $00^{\circ} 15' 40''$ West, 38.0 ft.

Thence South $00^{\circ} 15' 40''$ West from the intersection of the center of the open ditch and the quarter section line, a distance of 367.70 feet to a railroad spike in the south line of Section 26 and the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 1.386 Acres and being subject to 0.18 Ac. in road R/W.
