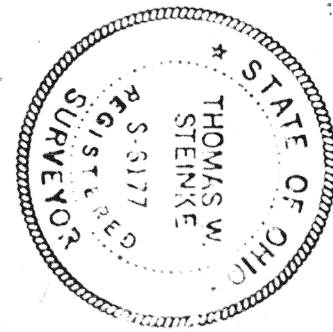

Town 6-S, Range 7-E, Clay Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and
being further described as follows:

Commencing at a monument box located at the north-east corner
of Section ~~25~~ 28

Thence North $90^{\circ} 00' 00''$ West with the north line of Section 28
and the center of Santa Fe-New Knoxville Road, a distance of
1742.11 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING for the
tract of land herein described.

Thence South $00^{\circ} 03' 40''$ West, a distance of 208.00 feet
to an iron pipe, passing through an iron pipe at 30.0 feet

Thence South $90^{\circ} 00' 00''$ East, a distance of 418.85 feet to an
iron pipe.

Thence South $00^{\circ} 03' 40''$ West, a distance of 2410.30 feet to
the center of an open ditch, passing through an iron pipe at
2393.30 feet.

Thence with the center of said ditch South $39^{\circ} 05' 00''$ West
a distance of 285.68 feet to a point in the east R/W of the D.P.&I
Railroad, reference by an iron pipe set North $17^{\circ} 26' 30''$ West,

railroad spike in the north line of Section 28

Thence South $90^{\circ} 00' 00''$ East with said Section line and the center
of Santa Fe-New Knoxville Road, a distance of 175.27 feet to a
railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein
described.
