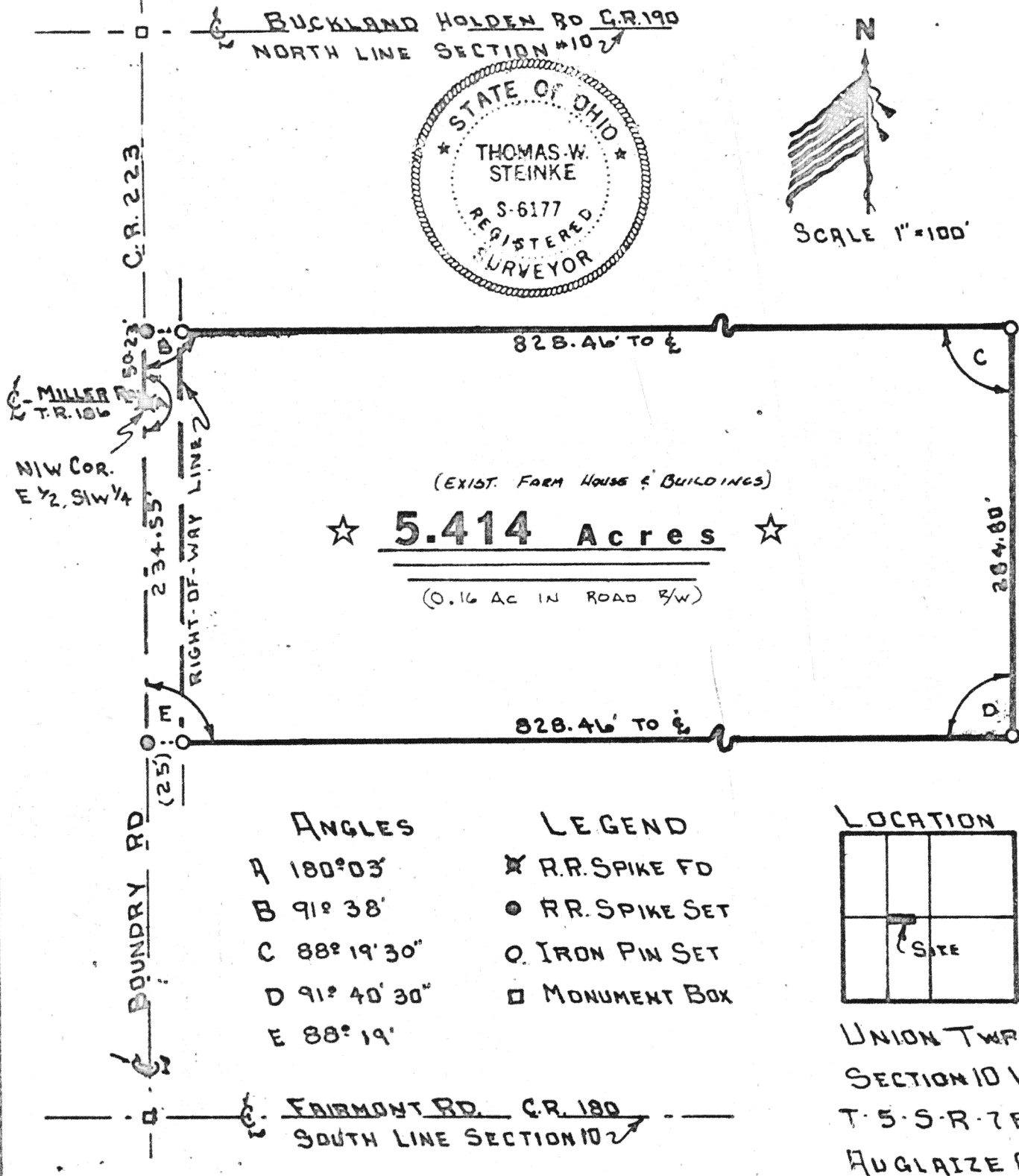

Being part of the west half of Section 10, T-5-S, R-7-E, Union Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike at the center line intersection of Miller Road P.R.# 186 and Boundary Road C.R.# 223, said point being the north-west corner of the south-east half quarter of the south-west quarter of Section 10 and the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described.

Thence north with the center of C.R.# 223, a distance of 50.23 feet to a railroad spike.

Thence east with an interior angle of $91^{\circ} 38'$, a distance of 828.46 feet to an iron bar, passing through an iron bar at 25.0 feet.

Thence south with an interior angle of $88^{\circ} 19' 30''$, a distance of 284.80 feet to an iron bar.

Thence west with an interior angle of $91^{\circ} 40' 30''$, a distance of 828.46 feet to a railroad spike in the center of C.R.# 223, passing through an iron bar at 803.46 feet.

Thence north with the center of C.R.# 223 with an interior angle of $88^{\circ} 19'$, a distance of 234.55 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING, making an interior angle with the beginning course of $180^{\circ} 03'$.

Containing in all 5.414 Acres and being subject to all legal easements and right-of-way of record.
