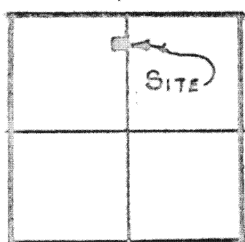

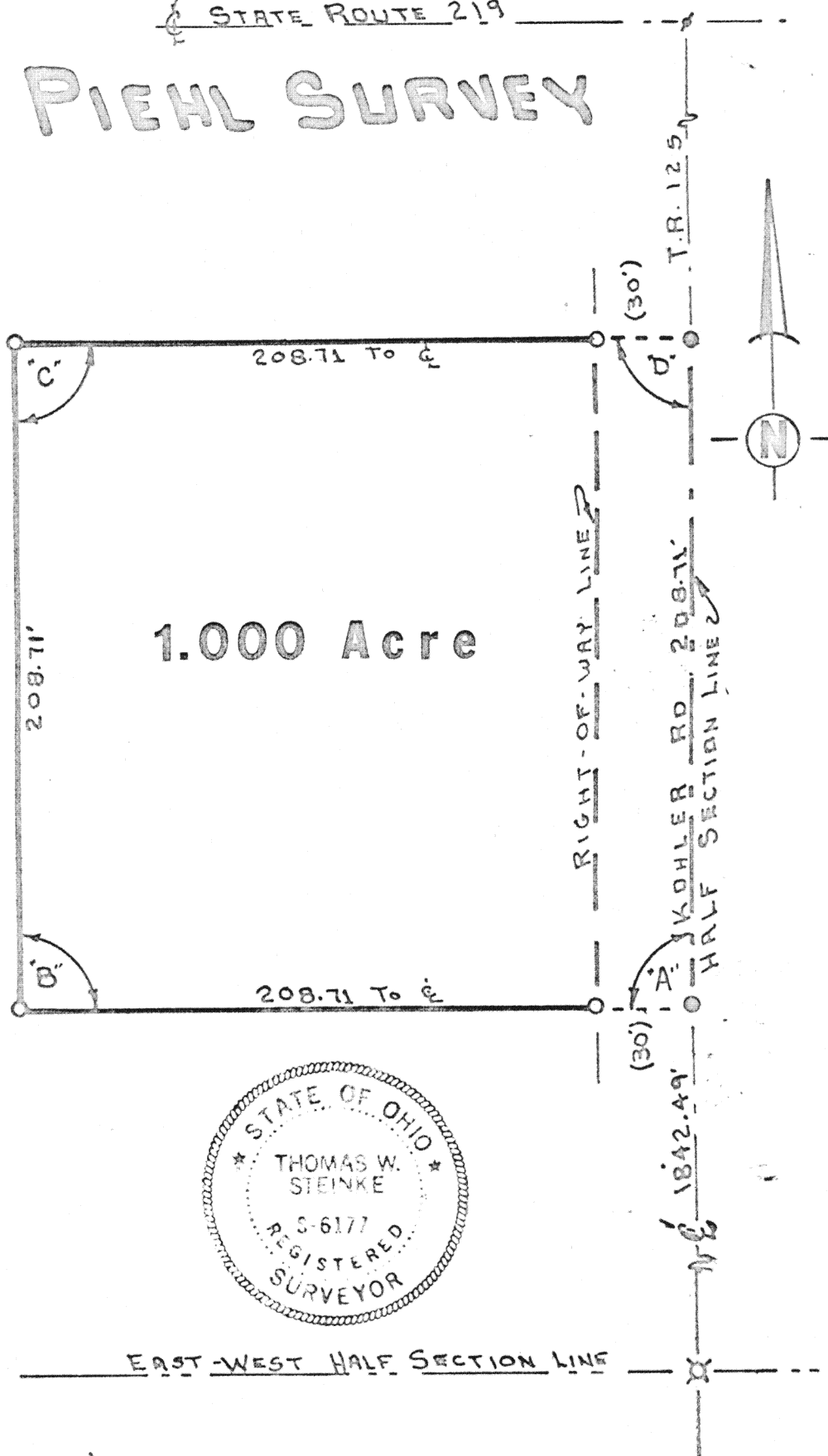

Being 1.000 Acre located in the north-west quarter of Section 25, T-6-S, R-5-E, Washington Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin at the south-east corner of the north-west quarter of Section 25.

Thence north with the north-south half section line and the center of Kohler Road P.R.# 125, a distance of 1842.49 feet to a railroad spike and the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described.

Thence continuing north with said half section line of section 25 and the center line of Kohler Road, a distance of 208.71 feet to a railroad spike.

Thence west with an interior angle of $90^{\circ} 00'$, a distance of 208.71 feet to an iron pipe, passing through an iron pipe at ~~208.71 feet~~ 30.0 feet

Thence south with an interior angle of $90^{\circ} 00'$, a distance of 208.71 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence east with an interior angle of $90^{\circ} 00'$, a distance of 208.71 feet to a railroad spike in the center of P.R.# 125 and the PLACE OF BEGINNING, passing through an iron pipe at 178.71 feet.
