NORTH SECTION LINE OF SECTION 33

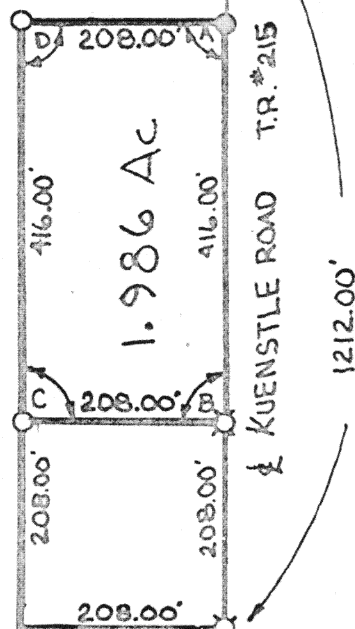

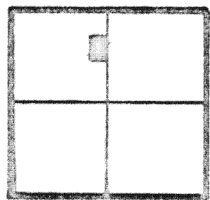

Description of 1.986 Acres for Franklin Taylor.

Being 1.986 Acres located in the north-west quarter of Section 33, Town-5-S, Range-7-E, Union Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at a monument box located at the north-east corner of the north-west quarter of Section 33, said point being the center line intersection of Middle Pike and Kuenstle Road.

Thence south with the center line of Kuanstle Road and the half section line of Section 33, a distance of 588.00 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING for the parcel herein described.

Thence continuing south with said center line and section line, a distance of 416.00 feet to an iron bar found.

Thence west with an interior angle of $90^{\circ} 47'$, a distance of 208.00 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence north with an interior angle of $89^{\circ} 13'$, a distance of 416.00 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence east with an interior angle of $90^{\circ} 47'$, a distance of 208.00 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING, making an interior angle with the beginning course of $89^{\circ} 13'$.

Containing in all 1.986 Acres and being subject to all legal easements and R/W of record.
