

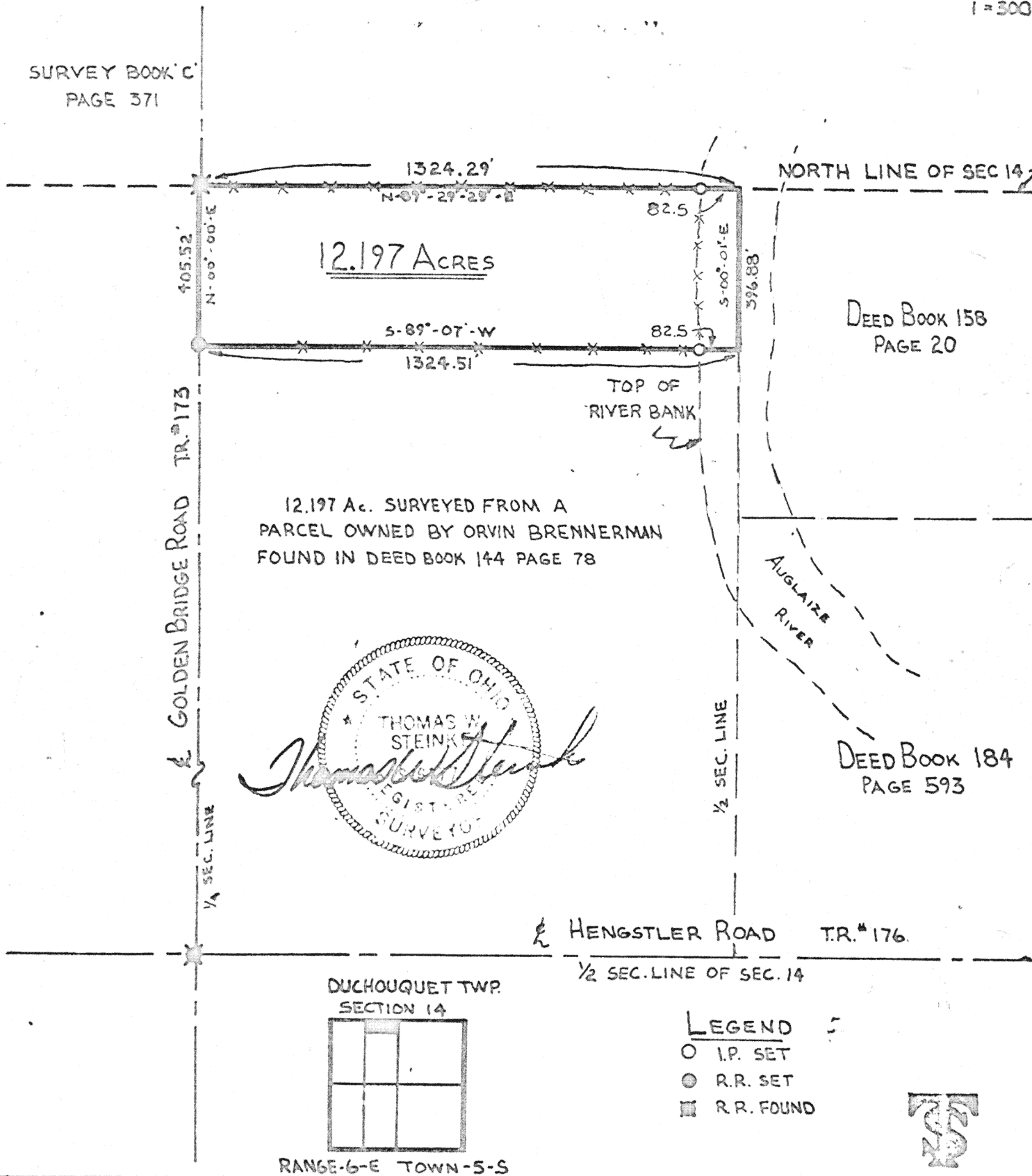

Being 12.197 Acres located in the north-west quarter of Section 14, T-5-S, R-6-E, Duchouquet Township, Auglaize County Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike located at the intersection of the north line of Section 14 and the center line of Golden Bridge Road ($\frac{1}{2}$ section line) and the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the parcel herein described.

Thence North $89^{\circ} 29' 25''$ East with the north line of Section 14, a distance of 1324.29 feet to a point in the Auglaize River, passing through an iron pipe at 1241.70 feet.

Thence South $00^{\circ} 01'$ East, a distance of 396.88 feet to a point.

Thence South $89^{\circ} 07'$ West, a distance of 1324.51 feet to a railroad spike in the center of Golden Bridge Road, passing through an iron pipe at 82.5 feet.

Thence North $00^{\circ} 00'$ East with said center line, a distance of 405.52 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 12.197 Acres and being subject to all legal easements and R/W of record.
