





Being 6.511 Acres located in the south-east quarter of Sec. 8, T-5-S, R-7-E, Union Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike in the center of Miller Road T.R.# 186 at the north-east corner of the north-west quarter of the south-east quarter of Section 8.

Thence North  $89^{\circ} 30'$  West with the half section line and the center of T.R.# 186, a distance of 872.78 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING for the parcel herein described.

Thence South  $01^{\circ} 22'$  West, a distance of 674.72 feet to an I.P..

Thence North  $89^{\circ} 33'$  West, a distance of 420.34 feet to an I.P..

Thence North  $01^{\circ} 22'$  East, a distance of 675.08 feet to a railroad spike in the center of T.R.# 186.

Thence South  $89^{\circ} 30'$  East with said center line, a distance of 420/26 feet to a railroad spike and PLACE OF BEGINNING.
