

The following described tract of land is part of the West half the Southeast Quarter of Section, 21, Town 5 South, Range 7 East, Union Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows.

Commencing at a railroad spike at the intersection of the East line of section 21, Union Township, and the center of the Blank Pike # 160, thence West along the center of Blank Pike # 160, 1322.20 feet to a railroad spike, this being the PLACE of BEGINNING.
Thence continuing West along the center of the Blank Pike # 160, 590.00 feet to a

railroad spike. Thence North 0 48' East(passing through an iron pipe set at 25.00 feet) 540.00 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence East 590.00 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence South 0 248 West (passing through a concrete post set at 521.68 feet) 540.00 feet to the railroad spike in the center of the Blank Pike #160 which was the PLACE of BEGINNING.

The above described tract of land contains 7.313 acres more or less, subject to 0.223 acres more or less dedicated to the public for highway purposes and to all other legal easements of record.
