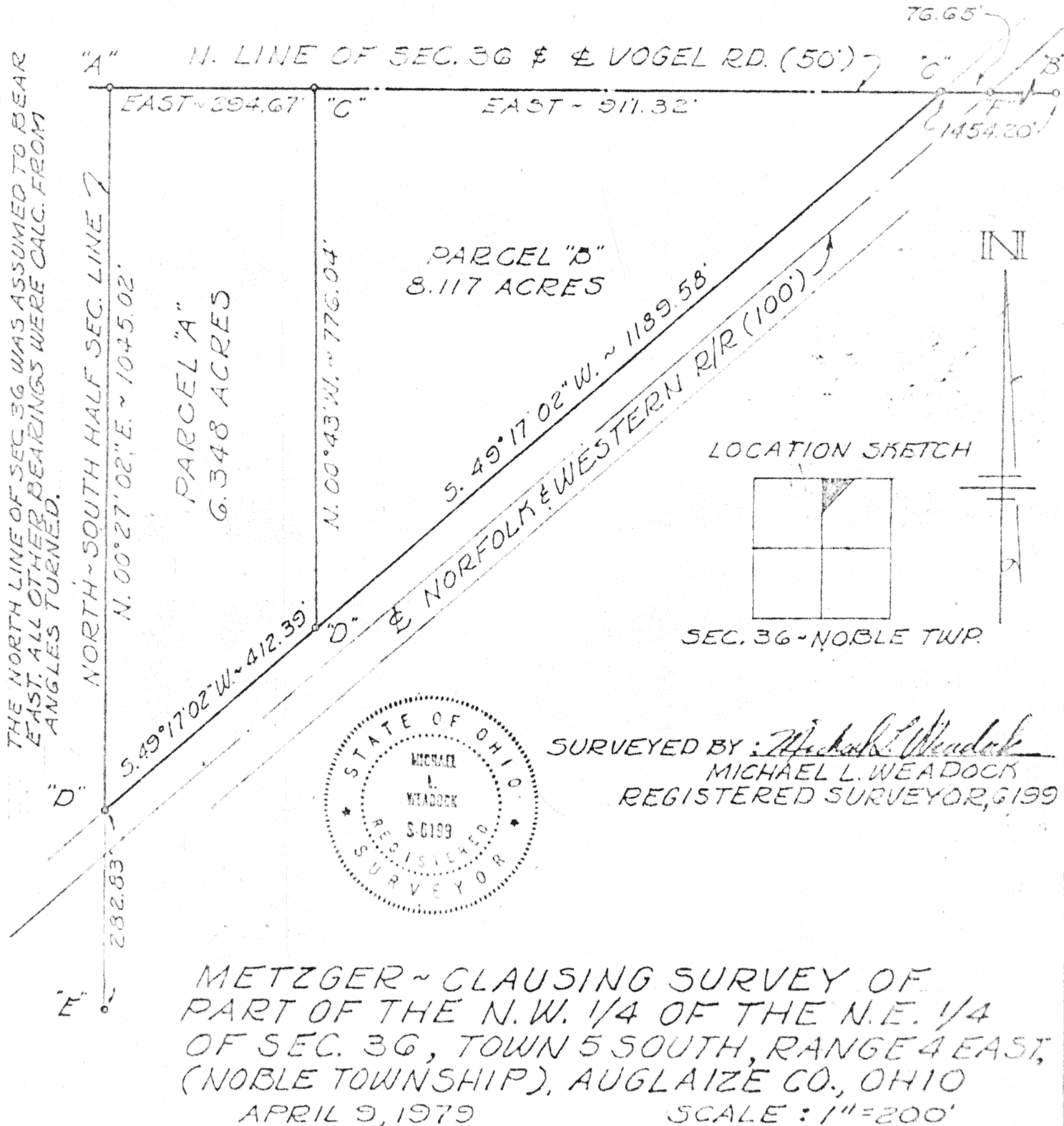

PARCEL "A"

Being a part of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 36, Town 5 South, Range 4 East, Noble Township), Auglaize County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

The place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument is a railroad spike set over the corner stone at the north quarter point of Section 36;

Thence, East, along the north line of the northeast quarter of said Section 36, a distance of two hundred ninety-four and 87/100 (294.67) feet to a railroad spike;

Thence, S. 00°43' E., a distance of seven hundred seventy-six and 04/100 (776.04) feet to a 5/8" iron bar set on the westerly right-of-way of the Norfolk and Western Railway;

Thence, S. 49°17' 02" W., along said Norfolk and Western Railway right-of-way, a distance of four hundred twelve and 39/100 (412.39) feet to a 5/8" iron bar set on the north-south half section line of said Section 36;

Thence, N. 00°27' 02" E., along the north-south half section line, a distance of one thousand forty-five and 02/100 (1045.02) feet to the place of beginning;

Containing 6.348 acres of land more or less.

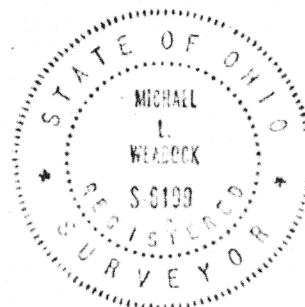

Being a part of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 36, Town 5 South, Range 4 East, (Noble Township), Auglaize County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a railroad spike set over the corner stone at the north quarter point of Section 36;

Thence, East, along the north line of the northeast quarter of said Section 36, a distance of two hundred ninety-four and 37/100 (294.67) feet to a railroad spike, said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument;

Thence, continuing, East, along the last described line a distance of nine hundred eleven and 32/100 (911.32) feet to a railroad spike;

Thence, S. 49°17' 02" W., along the westerly right-of-way line of the Norfolk and Western Railway, a distance of eleven hundred eighty-nine and 58/100 (1189.58) feet to a 5/8" iron bar;

Thence, N. 00°43' W., a distance of seven hundred seventy-six and 04/100 (776.04) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 8.117 acres of land more or less.

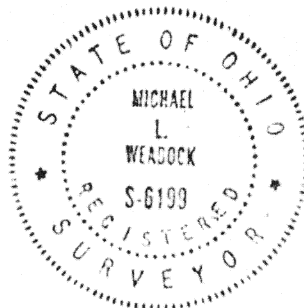
