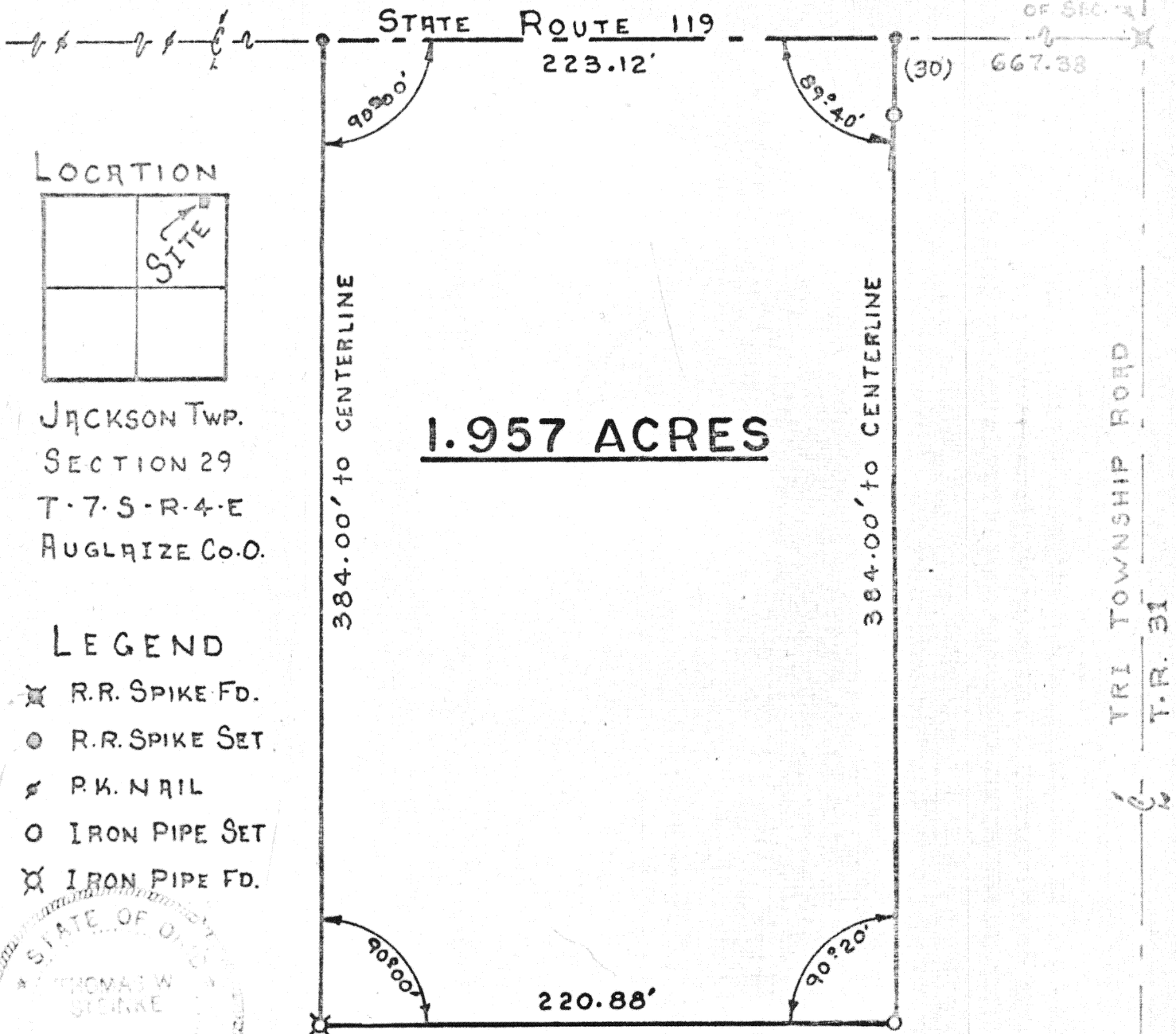

DESCRIPTION OF 1.957 ACRES.

Being 1.957 Acres located in the northeast quarter of Jackson Township Section 29 T-7-S-R-4-E Auglaize County Ohio and being further described as follows.

Commencing at the northeast corner of section 29 Jackson Township, said corner being marked by a railroad spike. Also being the centerline intersections of State Route 119 and Tri-Township Road (T-R 31) .

Thence in a westerly direction along the centerline of State Route 119 and the north line of section 29 a distance of 667.38 feet to a railroad spike and the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the parcel herein described.

Thence continuing along the centerline of State Route 119 and the north line of said section a distance of 223.12 feet to a railroad spike, being the northwest corner of this parcel.

Thence in a southerly direction with an angle to the right of $90^{\circ} 00'$ a distance of 384.00 feet to a iron pipe.

Thence in a easterly direction with an interior angle of $90^{\circ} 00'$ a distance of 220.88 feet to an iron pipe.

Thence in a northerly direction with an interior angle of $90^{\circ} 20'$ a distance of 384.00 feet to a railroad spike in the centerline of State Route 119 and a point on the north line of section 29, also being the PLACE OF BEGINNING for this parcel, passing through an iron pipe at 354.00 feet.

Containing in all 1.957 Acres and being subject to any and all easements and right-of-way of record.
