

Being all of lot # 1539 and part of lot # 1540 of the Franklin Addition on Plat Book 2, Page 67, in the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at the north-east corner of lot # 1539, said point being the intersection of the west right-of-way of Highland Street and the south right-of-way of an alley and the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Thence southward with the west R/W of Highland Street, a distance of 76.0 feet to a point.

Thence westward with an interior angle of $89^{\circ} 35' 30''$, a distance of 120.0 feet.

Thence northward with an interior angle of $90^{\circ} 24' 30''$, a distance of 76.0 feet to an iron pipe at the intersection of two allies.

Thence eastward with an interior angle of $89^{\circ} 35' 30''$, a distance of 120.0 feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING.
