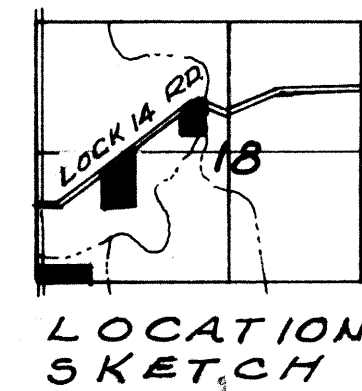

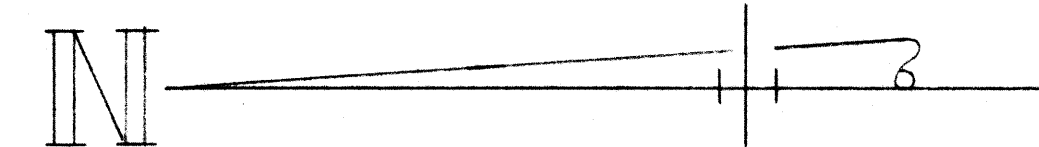

Being a parcel of land situated in Moulton Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the west half of Section 18, Township 5 South, Range 5 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at the corner stone at the southwest corner of said Section 18-

Thence, north, along the west line of said Section 18 and the centerline of Townline-Kossuth Road, a distance of one thousand four hundred thirty-seven (1437.00) feet to a railroad spike at the intersection of this described line with the centerline of Lock 14 Road-

Thence, north 82°06'12" east, along the centerline of said Lock 14 Road and the tangent to a 20 degree curve to the left in said centerline having a delta angle of 36°14'06", a distance of two hundred forty-eight and 02/100 (248.02) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar at the "P.I." of said curve-

Thence, north 45°52'06" east, along the tangent to the afore mentioned curve and the centerline of Lock 14 Road, a distance of two hundred forty-four and 24/100 (244.24) feet to a railroad spike. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument-

Thence, continuing north 45°52'06" east, along the last described line, a distance of five hundred ninety-seven and 01/100 (597.01) feet to a railroad spike-

Thence, south, a distance of six hundred eighty-three and 52/100 (682.52) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, south 81°21' west, a distance of four hundred thirty-three and 43/100 (433.43) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, north, a distance of three hundred thirty-three (333.00) feet to the place of beginning.

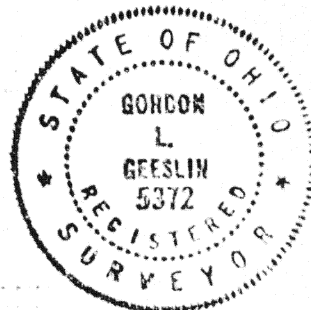

HOWELL SURVEY DESCRIPTION (TRACT THREE)

Being a parcel of land situated in Moulton Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the west half of Section 18, Township 5 South, Range 5 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at the corner stone at the southwest corner of said Section 18-

Thence, north, along the west line of said Section 18 and the centerline of Townline-Kossuth Road, a distance of one thousand four hundred thirty-seven (1437.00) feet to a railroad spike at the intersection of this described line with the centerline of Lock 14 Road-

Thence, north 82°06'12" east, along the centerline of said Lock 14 Road and the tangent to a 20 degree curve to the left in said centerline having a delta angle of 36°14'06", a distance of two hundred forty-eight and 02/100 (248.02) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar at the "P.I." of said curve-

Thence, north 45°52'06" east, along the tangent to the afore mentioned curve and the centerline of Lock 14 Road, a distance of three thousand six and 86/100 (3006.86) feet to a railroad spike. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument-

Thence, continuing north 45°52'06" east, along the last described line, a distance of one hundred thirty-six and 15/100 (136.15) feet to a railroad spike at the "P.C." of a 25 degree curve to the right having a delta angle of 58°30'45"-

Thence, along said curve, an arc distance of two hundred thirty-four and 05/100 (234.05) feet to the "P.T." of said curve. The chord to the last described call bears north 75°07'34" east, a distance of two hundred twenty-four and 01/100 (224.01) feet-

Thence, continuing along said centerline of Lock 14 Road, south 75°37'09" East, a distance of fifty-four and 02/100 (54.02) feet to a mine spike in the bridge over Six-mile Creek-

Thence, south 10°39'09" west, along the center of said Six-mile Creek, a distance of three hundred fifty-four and 41/100 (354.41) feet to a point-

Thence, leaving said creek, south 89°51' west, a distance of three hundred one and 03/100 (301.03) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar. Said line passing through a 5/8 inch iron bar at eighteen (18.00) feet-

Thence, north, a distance of two hundred ten and 20/100 (210.20) feet to the place of beginning.

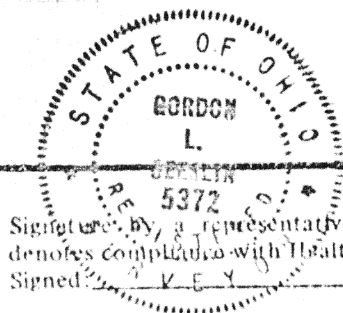
