Being 1.000 Acre located in the south-west quarter of Section 24, TOwn 7-S, Range 4-E, Jackson Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at the south-east corner of the southwest quarter of Section 24 and the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the parcel herein described.

Thence westward along the center line of Bensman Road C.R.# 40 and the south line of Section 24, a distance of 170.00 feet to a railroad spike.

Thence northward with an interior angle of 90° 04\* 50", a distance of 256.25 feet to an iron pipe, passing through an iron pipe at 25.0 feet.

Thence eastward with an interior angle of 89° 55\* 10", a distance of 170.00 feet to an iron pipe in the northsouth half section line.

Thence southward with an interior angle of  $90^{\circ}$  04, 50" along said half section line, a distance of 256.25 feet to a county monument box and the PLACE OF BEGINNING, passing through a wood corner post at 231.0 feet.

Containing in all 1.000 acre and being subject to all legal easements and right-of-ways of record.
