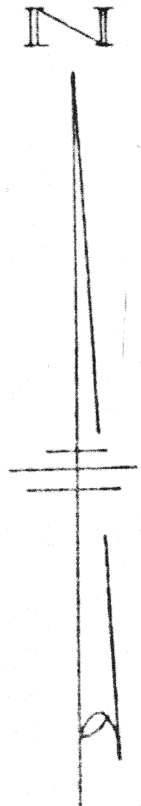

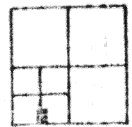

KATTERHEINRICH SURVEY DESCRIPTION



Scale _____

Being a parcel of land situated in Washington Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the southwest quarter of Section 22, Township 6 South, Range 5 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a railroad spike at the south quarter point of said Section 22;

Thence, south 89°32' 40" west, along the south line of the southwest quarter of said Section 22 and the centerline of State Route #219, a distance of one thousand one hundred four and 73/100 (1104.73) feet to a railroad spike. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument;

Thence, continuing south 89°32' 40" west, along the last described line, a distance of two hundred fifty and 00/100 (250.00) feet to a railroad spike;

Thence, north 0°27' 20" west, a distance of three hundred eighty-one and 26/100 (381.26) feet to a 5/8" iron bar,

Thence, north 89°39' 16" east, a distance of two hundred fifty and 00/100 (250.00) feet to a 5/8" iron bar;

Thence, south 0°27' 20" east, a distance of three hundred eighty and 78/100 (380.78) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 2.1867 acres of land more or less.

Subject to all easements and right-Of-way of record.

The south line of the southwest quarter of Section 22 was assumed to bear south 89°32' 40" west. All other bearings were calculated from angles turned.

Reference is made to a survey of this area by Michael L. Weadock, Registered Surveyor #6199, on file in the County Engineer's Office.
