Being 1.000 Acres located in the southwest quarter of section 2 German Township T-7-S-R-4-E Auglaize County, Ohio, and being further described as follows.

Commencing at the southwest corner of section 2 said point being marked by a P.K. nail, also being the centerline intersections of Lock Two Road (C-R 70) and Quelhorst Road (C-R 41) .

Thence in a northerly direction along the centerline of Quelhorst Road and the west line of section 2 a distance of 181.50 feet to a railroad spike and the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the parcel herein described.

Thence continuing on said centerline and west line of said section a distance of 232.43 feet to a P.K. nail.

Thence in a easterly direction with an angle to the left of $88^{\circ} 50'$ a distance of 269.55 feet to a P.K. nail in the centerline of New Bremen New Knoxville Road (C-R 65-A) .

Thence in a southwesterly direction with an interior angle of $56^{\circ} 02'$ along the centerline of C-R 65-A a distance of 160.60 feet to a P.K. nail

Thence in a southwesterly direction with an interior angle of $178^{\circ} 09'$ along said centerline a distance of 118.95 feet to a railroad spike.

Thence in a westerly direction with an interior angle of $127^{\circ} 17' 40''$ a distance of 105.50 feet to a railroad spike in the centerline of Quelhorst Road and a point on the west line of said section, also being the PLACE OF BEGINNING for this parcel.

Thence continuing on said centerline and west line of said section a distance of 108.25 feet to a P.K. nail, marking the northwest corner of this parcel.

Thence in a easterly direction with an angle to the left of $88^{\circ} 50'$ a distance of 439.95 feet to a P.K. nail in the centerline of New Bremen New Knoxville Road (C-R 65-A).

Thence in a southwesterly direction with an interior angle of $56^{\circ} 02'$ along the centerline of C-R. 65-A a distance of 130.50 feet to a P.K. Nail.

Thence in a westerly direction with an interior angle of $123^{\circ} 58'$ a distance of 364.85 feet to a P.K. nail in the centerline of Quelhorst Road and a point on the west line of section 2, also being the PLACE OF BEGINNING for this parcel.
