

The following described tract of land is part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 7, Clay Township, Town 6 South, Range 7 East, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a monument box at the Southeast corner of Section 7, Clay Township and the centerline of County Road 201 (formerly known as the Ashburn Road);

Thence with an assumed bearing of N.00000 E. along the East line of Section 7, Clay Township and the centerline of County Road 201, a distance of 796.56 feet to a spike which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING; Thence continuing N.0000E. along the East line of Section 7,

Clay Township and the centerline of County Road 201 a distance of 530.00 feet to a spike; Thence N.90000%. a distance of 258.25 feet to a concrete end

Thence S.000000 W. a distance of 530.00 feet to an iron pin; Thence S.90000 E. a distance of 258.25 feet to a spike which was the PLACE OF BEGINNING.
