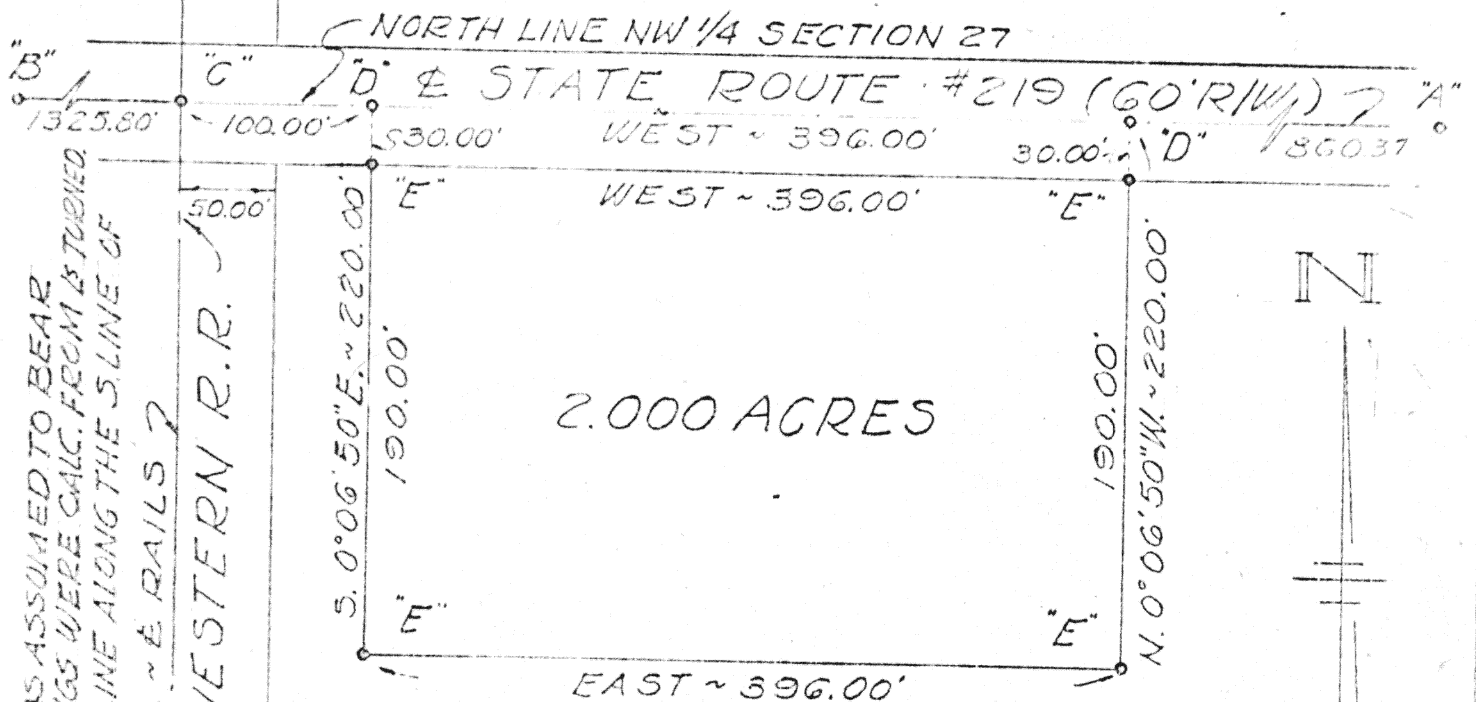

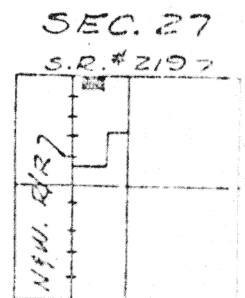

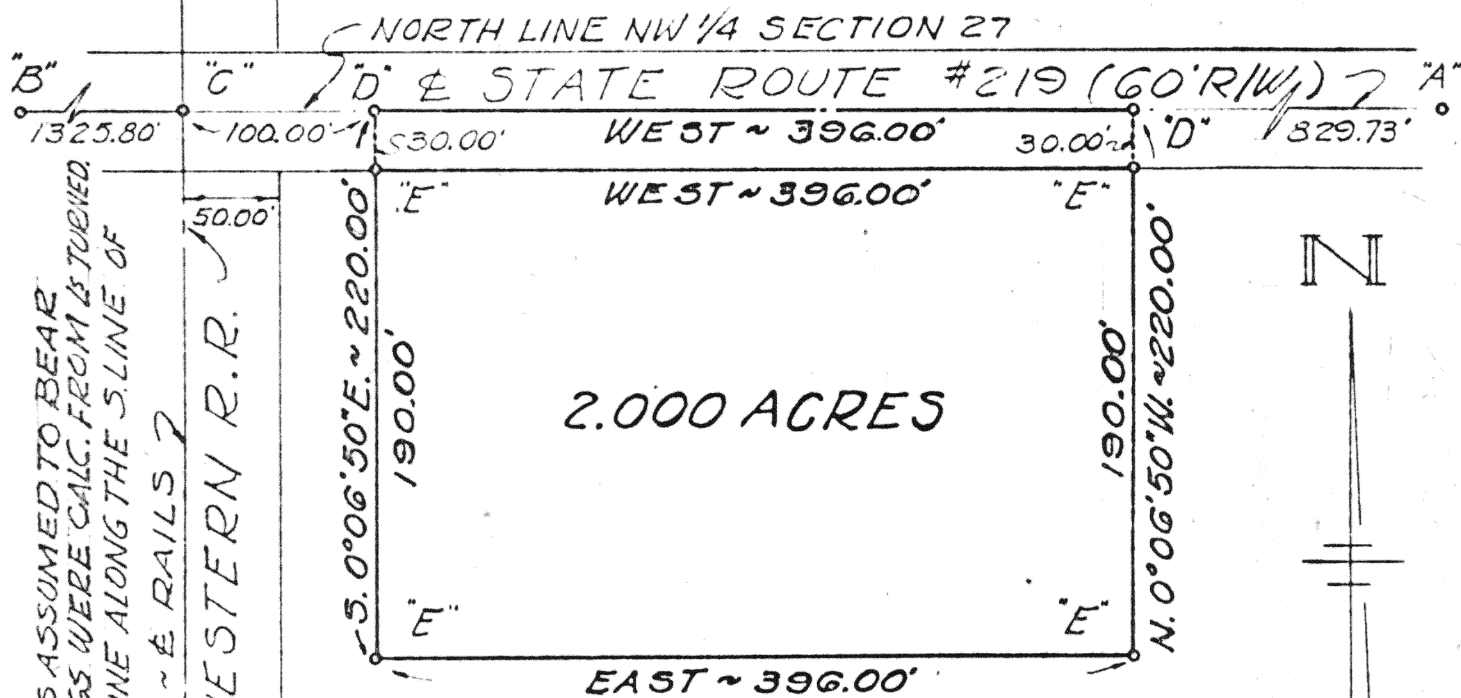

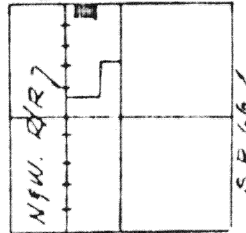

QUELLHORST SURVEY DESCRIPTION



Being a parcel of land situated in St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 27, Township 6 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a railroad spike set over the corner stone at the north quarter post of said Section 27;

Thence, West, along the north line of northwest quarter of said Section 27 and the centerline of State Route #219, a distance of eight hundred sixty and 37/100 (860.37) feet to a railroad spike, said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument;

Thence, continuing, West, along the last described line, a distance of three hundred ninety-six and 00/100 (396.00) feet to a railroad spike;

Thence, South 0° 06' 50" East, parallel with the centerline of the Norfolk and Western Railway, a distance of two hundred twenty and 00/100 (220.00) feet to a 5/8" iron bar, said line passing thru a 5/8" iron bar at thirty and 00/100 (30.00) feet;

Thence, East, parallel with the north line of said Section 27 and the centerline of State Route #219, a distance of three hundred ninety-six and 00/100 (396.00) feet to a 5/8" iron bar;

Thence, North 0° 06' 50" West, parallel with said centerline of the Norfolk and Western Railway, a distance of two hundred twenty and 00/100 (220.00) feet, said line passing thru a 5/8" iron bar at one hundred ninety and 00/100 (190.00) feet.

Containing 2.000 acres of land more or less of which 0.273 acre is in road right-of-way.

Subject to all easements and rights-of-way of record.

The centerline of State Route #219 was assumed to bear East-West. All other bearings were calculated from angles turned.

This description was prepared from a survey of this parcel completed in August of 1980, on file in the County Recorder's Office.

Thence, West, along the north line of northwest quarter of said Section 27 and the centerline of State Route #219, a distance of eight hundred twenty-nine and 73/100 (829.73) feet to a railroad spike, said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument;

Thence, continuing, West, along the last described line, a distance of three hundred ninety-six and 00/100 (396.00) feet to a railroad spike;

Thence, South 0° 06' 50" East, parallel with the centerline of the Norfolk and Western Railway, a distance of two hundred twenty and 00/100 (220.00) feet to a 5/8" iron bar, said line passing thru a 5/8" iron bar at thirty and 00/100 (30.00) feet;

Thence, East, parallel with the north line of said Section 27 and the centerline of State Route #219, a distance of three hundred ninety-six and 00/100 (396.00) feet to a 5/8" iron bar;

Thence, North 0° 06' 50" West, parallel with said centerline of the Norfolk and Western Railway, a distance of two hundred twenty and 00/100 (220.00) feet, said line passing thru a 5/8" iron bar at one hundred ninety and 00/100 (190.00) feet.
