

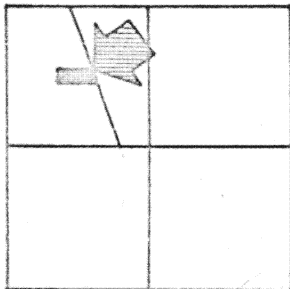

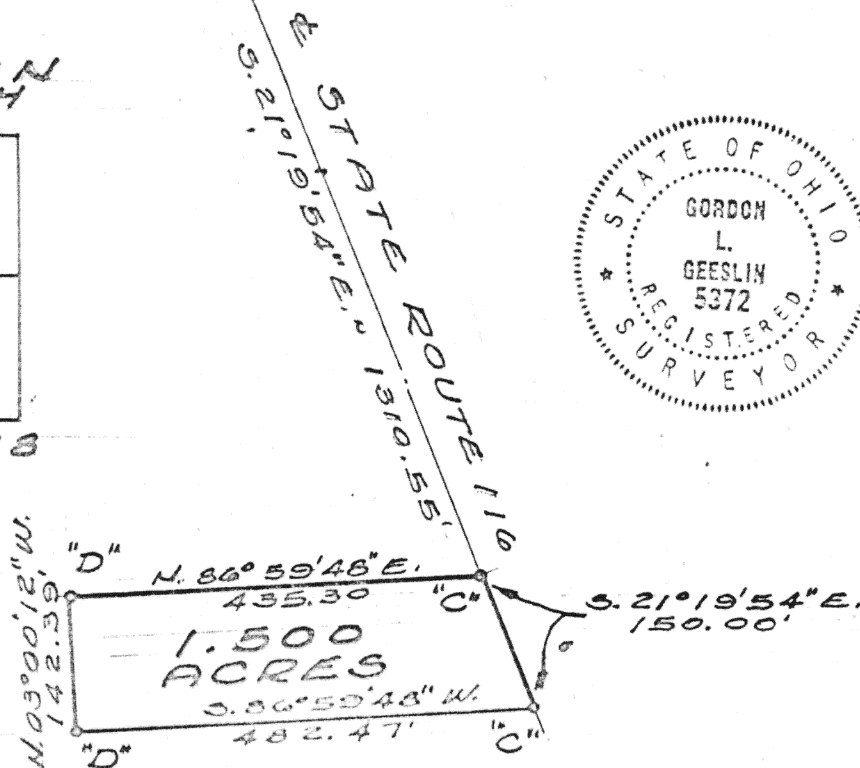

VOGEL SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in Noble Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the northwest quarter of Section 28, Township 5 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at an iron bar in a monument box at the north-west corner of said Section 28-

Thence, east, along the north line of said northwest quarter of Section 28, and the centerline of Glynwood Road, a distance of nine hundred eighty-one and 10/100 (981.10) feet to a railroad spike in the centerline of State Route 116-

Thence, south $21^{\circ}19'54''$ east, along said centerline of State Route 116, a distance of one thousand three hundred ten and 55/100 (1310.55) feet to a railroad spike. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument-

Thence, continuing south $21^{\circ}19'54''$ east, along the last described line, a distance of one hundred fifty (150.00) feet to a railroad spike-

Thence, south $86^{\circ}59'48''$ west, a distance of four hundred eighty-two and 47/100 (482.47) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, north $03^{\circ}00'12''$ west, a distance of one hundred forty-two and 39/100 (142.39) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, north $86^{\circ}59'48''$ east, a distance of four hundred thirty-five and 30/100 (435.30) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 1.500 acres of land more or less.

Subject to all easements and right-of-way of record.
